WATER TANK FILTRATION SYSTEM = CONSTANT SUPPLY OF CLEAN WATER = GOOD HEALTH



FROM STEPHEN DARBY

Our next major project will be the purchase and construction of a water tower complete with tank and filtration system to supply the home with a quality water supply.

The reason for the water tower is that we have a lot of power outages here and we are currently drawing water from a well using electric pumps which means **No power = No water**.

The cost for the water tower system is between \$5,000 and \$6,000 that includes a filter to give a better quality of water.

Helping someone with a disability with the gift of a goat means they will have a regular source of milk added to their diet and manure to grow more nutritious food.



A GOAT = \$55

Buy a goat and contribute to a long term poverty-fighting project.

Milk and cheese for food, fertilizer for the soil for crop growing.

The milk and cheese are great but the gift of a goat is also a real economic benefit to rural families.

Breeding goats helps gain extra income to spend on health, education and other family needs.

GOATS AND CHICKENS = NUTRITION AND INCOME

CHICKENS FOR 5 FAMILIES

You can provide a new source of income and more food for 5 families living with disability, through the regular supply of eggs.



CHICKENS = \$65

Rearing chickens provides extra food and income for families facing poverty.

Eggs to eat, trade or sell and also breeding and selling baby chicks at market.

Each family receives 3-5 chickens depending on the size of the family.
