A volunteer-based non-profit organisation that was born out of the ashes of Black Saturday 2009 in Australia.

BlazeAid works with families and individuals in rural Australia after natural disasters such as fires and floods. Working alongside the rural families, volunteers have helped to rebuild fences and other structures that have been damaged or destroyed.

In addition, they have helped to remove hundreds of kilometres of damaged fencing, removed fallen trees from fence lines, helped with gardening projects, and even built the odd chook shed.

Equally important, volunteers also help to lift the spirits of people who are often facing their second or third flood event after years of drought, or devastating losses through bushfires.

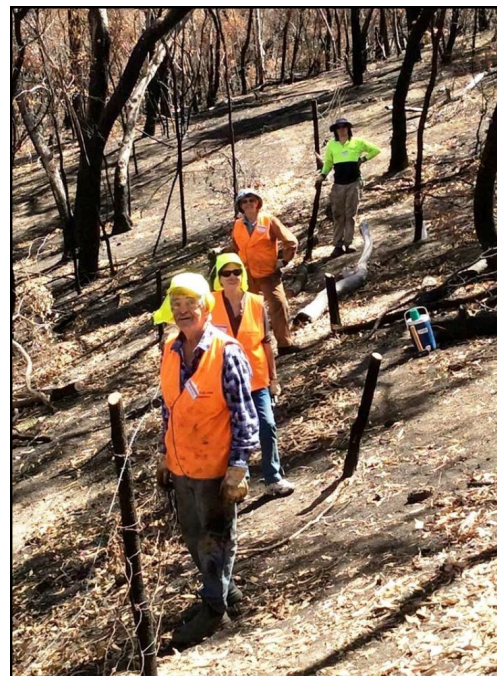
