'Many people in remote parts of PNG can't improve their eyesight, whether it's for prescription or reading glasses.


After receiving prescribed glasses, it's like opening a window and being able to see up close or far away.'

They would like your old prescription glasses and sunglasses to assist people who have poor vision and to restore sight to those they can.


Please donate any of your unwanted spectacles so we can be a blessing to those less fortunate in PNG.
