

AFRICA - MALAWI KONDANANI CHILDREN'S VILLAGE

" KONDANANI "

(means Love One Another)
It is a home for the orphaned young, some with HIV/AIDS.

It is a place of hope and of life where a child can find a family, love and care, a fresh start and a brighter future.

'KONDANANI' WILL CELEBRATE 20 YEARS OF FAITHFUL MINISTRY IN NOVEMBER 2018. GOD HAS SHOWN UP OVER AND OVER AGAIN.

HE HAS NEVER RELEASED HIS HOLD ON THEM.

The need for the establishment of Kondanani Orphanage arose due to the high rate of HIV/AIDS infection in the country, which is continuing to rob many children of their parents. Because many other orphanages would not admit these babies due to the cost, and the fact that it is labour-intensive, Kondanani embarked on admitting such babies rather than leaving them to die in the villages.

The first baby was admitted to their Caring Hands Infant Home on 7 November 1998. Every baby admitted to Kondanani is first sent to Caring Hands. When they turn three, they are integrated into either the Girls Village or the Boys Village.

All the children are fed, clothed, educated, have complete medical and dental care and grow spiritually with the LOVE of JESUS.



They have 166 children in total (92 Boys & 74 Girls), all below the age of 18.



AMERICAS - OUTPOST PANAMA YWAM MEDICAL SHIPS

TO KNOW GOD AND TO MAKE HIM KNOWN

Outpost Panama is what YWAM call their base in Panama. It is on the island of Bastimento on the Caribbean Sea side of northern Panama, in the jungle, with it's own dock, nestled among many indigenous Ngobe Indian tribes.

With 6 vessels of varying sizes, small enough to travel up rivers to remote areas all within one day's sail, the volunteers can reach well over 50 villages that are completely isolated from regular access. Their boats can pull alongside, drop anchor and they can take their time helping the tribal people.

The medical teams go out to these villages for a week at a time, returning to base for a rest and restocking, then the teams go back out again for another cycle.
