This is an opportunity to be part of a dynamic and vibrant team who play a vital role in supporting individuals and communities to become more connected and resilient.

Dial-OP & GO offers a multi-layered support service to people in Dundee that provides information, connectivity and reassurance through the different activities delivered by the project or by referring them on to other organisations and services.

Dial-OP & GO is committed to ensuring individuals gain easy access to tailored information on local services and community resources, and have opportunities to increase their social interactions in a way that suits their personal circumstances and meets their individual needs. Dial-OP & GO volunteers play a fundamental role in the delivery and success of the project, supported by a small team of paid staff.

# PURPOSE OF POST:

- To support the team with the ongoing delivery and coordination of existing, and future, Dial-OP & GO, including the recruitment and training of volunteers.
- Establish and maintain partnerships and working relationships with individuals, local communities, Third Sector and statutory partners.
- Identify and develop opportunities to tackle loneliness, build more integrated and resilient communities, and create pathways for individuals to better their lives.

### **KEY DUTIES:**

- Ensure the effective management of incoming referrals, identify suitable sources of support along with the Project Coordinator and arrange positive volunteer-service user matches.
- Source, coordinate and support volunteers in their role of offering companionship, practical and/or emotional support, ensuring they are satisfied and well-placed.
- Ensure that the project progresses in line with the project plan and evolves in line with identified needs and expectations.
- Participate in the daily running and management of Dial-OP & GO services.
- Work to meet the project outcomes and undertake monitoring, reporting and evaluation of the project.
- Promote the work of Volunteer Dundee and Dundee's Third Sector Interface.
