Working closely with surrounding communities, the Civic Street Cycling Hub will offer a programme of regular activities, services and events to encourage more people in the area to cycle as a mode of transport.

We need someone with a creative and community focused approach and who can evidence excellent people skills. Candidates should be passionate about increasing the number of people who choose to cycle as their main mode of travel.

Initially this is a one year contract thanks to funding from Paths for All's Open Fund. However, we are looking for someone who is ambitious and has the drive to develop the Civic Street Cycling hub into a long-term facility for the community.
