Job Description

This is an exciting role, with elements of food preparation and youth work, around a core of excellent customer service and relationship building.

Working directly with the catering manager, the Scran Café Manager will be accountable for the smooth and financially successful running of our café at the NHS Comely Bank Training Centre.

Main Responsibilities

Lead the social and commercial impact of the café

- o Provide an outstanding food and drink offer for frontline NHS staff
- o Connect to customers, providing service that makes them want to come back
- Support the function of the café as a community hub
- o Help create, develop and communicate the potential of the café
- Keep an exceptional standard of cleanliness
- Monitor and maintain a HACCP based food management system and cooksafe house rules
- Meet sales targets and stick to budgets
- o Place orders and work with suppliers

Support food production and delivery across the organisation

- Alongside the catering team coordinate and support in food production for our food truck the Scran Van
- Support in commercial outside catering work, including menu development and costing
- Support in occasional food provision for young people's events and trips

Support the delivery of vocational education for Scran Academy's young people

- o Provide a confidence-building, inspiring environment for young people
- Alongside the youth work team and young people, support development and design of education and employability programmes for young people
- Alongside the youth work team, provide empowering food training sessions for young people

• Support the delivery of the Scransitions employability scheme

- Coordinate with the youth work team to create meaningful positive work experience placements in the cafe
- Support young people who transition from the Academy to the Van, the Café and into professional environments
