The Role

Are you passionate about helping people to food security?

Taking a person-centred approach, you will work with individuals to enable them to identify personal outcomes and priorities for their health and well-being and link them to local, city and national activities and support services.

The postholder must have experience of working with people who are facing complex social and emotional circumstances, a strong understanding of the challenges affecting people living in areas of disadvantage in relation to living well, extensive effective interpersonal skills in working with people on a 1:1 basis as well as experience in networking and relationship building with other professionals and organisations.

PVG: This post requires membership of the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme. Application will be processed for the successful candidate.

The Service User Engagement Manager will:

- take the lead in establishing an effective engagement model with people getting in touch with us for support to ensure a person-centred approach is adopted
- develop an approach to build a deeper understanding of how we can support service users' short-term food needs, and direct them to other existing specialised services in place within their communities
- actively participate in establishing close relationships with a wide range of external networks for the benefit of service users, including health practitioners, employability services, community centred support services and local authorities
- provide training to lead, motivate, develop and supervise the (volunteer) service user engagement team



Skills & Experience

The successful candidate will have:

- specialist knowledge and experience of working with vulnerable people, multi-agency working, and the ability to problem-solve
- extensive experience in front line services, combined with a background in delivering training, guidance and support to colleagues covering safeguarding and conflict resolution
- a non-judgemental attitude and willingness to embrace diversity, and work collaboratively within a small organisation
- an excellent track record of relationship building skills with other voluntary and statutory agencies
- a proactive approach to service user participation and engagement
- experience of managing a team, setting clear objectives and coordinating priorities across other internal teams, with the ability to remain focused in the face of conflicting demands
- strong written communication skills including the ability to write clear and concise reports
