Main Role

DD8 Music is looking to recruit a Music Development Worker to support the provision of DD8 Music activities, play the lead role on current DD8 Music projects such as *Beyond the Stage* and *Jamshed* - develop new opportunities and respond to the needs and desires of the people involved. The worker will provide a safe and inclusive environment within DD8 Music, adhering to and promoting DD8 Music's aims, policies and procedures

Reporting directly to the Manager of DD8 Music, you will play a pivotal role in the team at DD8 Music.

- Work on and develop current projects and activities based around DD8 Music's mission, vision and values
- Run drop-in sessions and project work
- Seek to actively engage the local community to better understand their local wants and needs to aid DD8 Music in its goal to be community led in its activities
- Identify community skills, assets, issues and needs
- Develop new resources in dialogue with the community and evaluate existing programmes
- Build links with other groups and agencies
- Help to raise public awareness on issues relevant to the community
- Prepare reports on activities – gathering feedback from participant/parents/carers
- Liaise with interested groups and individuals to set up new services

- Mediate in matters of conflict
- Encourage participation in activities
- Challenge inappropriate behaviour
- Carry out general administrative duties
- Provide and act as a role model to children and young people
- Organise social and recreational activities, encourage participation and help to develop social interactions
- Work with DD8 Music's values at the heart of everything you do
- Supporting the DD8 Music members to develop their own activities
- Aid in the upkeep of the studio, recording equipment and instruments
