Principle Terms and Conditions

- Funding currently exists for this post till Summer 2025.
- The salary for this full-time 35 hours per week post is £23,624- £26,139
- Due to the nature of this post, a flexible approach to working hours is required and will include some evening and weekend work, including attendance at residential events during school holidays which will include overnight stays. Authorised time off in lieu will be given.
- Whilst the post is based in Glasgow at the GK experience's office 759 Argyle Street, Glasgow, G3 8DS - you will be working with local communities and in rural residential locations across Scotland. Travel will therefore be required.
- Annual leave entitlement is 22 days rising to 25 days after two years' service. In addition, an entitlement to 10 public holiday is given. The holiday year runs from 1 April to 31 March.
- In order to comply with the Immigration, Asylum and Nationality Act 2006, all candidates invited to interview, will be asked to provide document(s) confirming their eligibility to work in the United Kingdom.
- Employment is conditional on the successful candidate being a member of the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme. The relevant vetting expenses will be paid for by the GK experience.
- After successful completion of a three-month probationary period, you will be auto enrolled into a workplace pensions plan, where a mandatory 8% contribution will be made up by: employer's contribution of 7.5% of salary plus an employee contribution of 0.5%. This will be backdated to the date of commencement of employment.
