WHAT IS ONE DALKEITH?

A CHARITY AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST

One Dalkeith is a volunteer-led charity where many local people give up their spare time to make One Dalkeith happen.

One Dalkeith is run and owned by the local community, for the local community. It was created following extensive community consultations and was established as a Community Development Trust and Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO) in 2017.

Through these consultations, the local community set out its vision, mission and aims to improve and enhance local community life.

THE VISION, MISSION & AIMS OF ONE DALKEITH

The community's vision for Dalkeith is to have a healthy natural environment, an attractive built environment, and a diverse & vibrant economy & culture with inclusivity for all.



One Dalkeith's mission is to improve Dalkeith: socially, economically, and environmentally.

One Dalkeith aims to do this by: regenerating the Town Centre, providing community facilities, growing the collective economic well-being of the community, enhance local arts, culture, and heritage, & improving the local environment.

As an anchor Organisation, One Dalkeith makes vital connections that build local wealth, resilience, and well-being within the local communities surrounding the Dalkeith district.

ACTIVITIES

The One Dalkeith Hub has a seasonal programme of community-led activities, events, workshops and classes for everyone to enjoy and up their skills!

Enjoy a movie in Dalkeith's Circle Cinema, come along to one of the community fairs, or learn a new skill such as cookery, drawing, DIY, or crafts at a community workshop.

With a mix of free and paid events, prebooked or drop-in, there is something for everyone.





ONE DALKEITH'S LABORATORY OF IMAGINATION

The Laboratory of Imagination is the collective name for the clubs and workshops run by One Dalkeith. The topics and themes of each workshop are shaped by continuous feedback and engagement with the local community.

In 2024 One Dalkeith received funding from The National Lottery to run activities over the next 3 years, covering five areas: the arts, technology, food, practical skills and community events.

IDEA

IDEA explores the creative and cultural arts and includes community activities ranging from sewing and craft workshops to music and theatre groups.







TECH

TECH aims to increase the community's digital literacy through kid's coding clubs, robotics clubs & graphic design.





SKILLS

SKILLS provides workshops and clubs in the community to teach people to restore, repurpose, repair and create their own bespoke pieces in the Hub's woodworking workshop.









TASTE

Taste workshops provide the community with the skills they need to explore their culinary talent through cooking, baking, and hospitality training.







CINEMA

One Dalkeith runs monthly and seasonal affordable family cinema in the Hub's very own 130 seat cinema space: The Circle.


