Glasgow SE Foodbank

Vision: to reduce the need for Foodbanks by working with others to help people access resources and funds, so they have enough money to live on.

Mission: to relieve the suffering of those in crisis, or hardship, who have been referred by the welfare organisations in our area.

Values: to advance the Christian faith by demonstrating God's love to those we serve.

Aims: to co-operate and collaborate with other charities who have the same or similar objectives as Glasgow SE Foodbank, by exchanging information and advice.

To raise funds, invite, receive and make donations to and from other charities with similar objectives.

To promote and fulfil charitable commitments to benefit the community in the Glasgow South East area.

Improve people's lives by signposting them to and helping them access benefits and other resources to which they are entitled; thereby reducing the need for people to require emergency food.

Develop our staff and volunteer teams by offering them relevant training so that they have the necessary knowledge and information to support our service users.
