We are Right There and recently celebrated our 200th anniversary in 2024. We provide tailored support for people, at home, and in the community. We are here for people who are living with the effects of homelessness, poverty, addiction, or family breakdowns. Last year we supported almost 4,000 individuals, helping to prevent them from becoming homeless or separated from the people they love.

We are here to offer the right support at the right time, including breaking down financial barriers; accessing the private rental market; linking up with local health, employment and training services to help people make connections within the community; and helping people feel happier, safer, and more confident to take steps to improve their own lives.

Every person's story is unique, and everyone's route home is different, so we tailor our response to the individual. We want to challenge stereotypes - it doesn't matter what the situation is we're not here to judge, only to help.

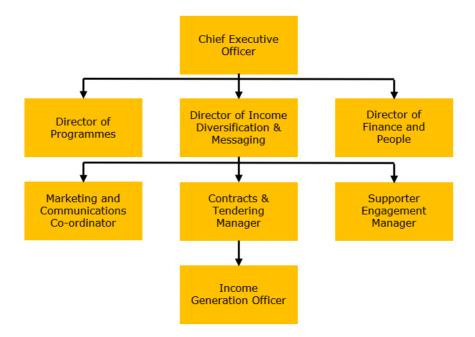


Job Title: Director of Income Diversification & Messaging

In this newly shaped position, you will play a pivotal role in ensuring the long-term financial sustainability and growth of Right There by developing and executing comprehensive fundraising, communications, and income generation/diversification strategies.

Reporting to the Chief Executive you will be responsible for increasing Right There's contract (commissioned) and non-contract income in alignment with the organisation's growth plan.

As a key member of the Leadership Team, you will collaborate closely with colleagues, providing expert and insightful support, & challenge when required, to actively shaping strategies and operational plans that drive the achievement of our mission and strategic priorities.

To have a **positive impact** in the role you will:

- Build and oversee the Income Diversification & Messaging team, fostering a collaborative and results-driven culture to drive excellence in contract tendering, fundraising, and communications
- Develop and implement strategies to achieve financial targets through diverse and sustainable funding streams, regularly monitoring and reporting on performance

The Opportunity



- Oversee the delivery of Right There's fundraising strategy, ensuring income diversification while deepening relationships with supporters, donors, and volunteers - both now and in the future
- Support the Contracts and Tendering Manager in securing local authority contracts, providing strategic oversight and internal guidance to drive successful tender outcomes and business growth
- Enhance Right There's external communications and marketing activities and implement strategies that directly support income growth and expand Right There's supporter base
- Raise Right There's profile by building and maintaining key external relationships, ensuring the organisation is a first-choice partner for commissioners, grant-making bodies, and key decision-makers
- Working closely with the Director of Programmes and relevant Heads of Service, as appropriate, to scope, understand and analyse opportunities in new and current geographical areas, identifying and evaluating new business opportunities and potential funding streams
- Embed an agile approach to income generation by conducting regular horizon scanning and environmental analysis, ensuring a deep understanding of the funding landscape (both statutory and non-statutory) to inform strategic growth and development
- Oversee the full procurement lifecycle and lead the development of business growth initiatives, ensuring sustainable expansion and financial resilience
- Ensure that risk is appropriately evaluated and minimised in all business propositions
- Act as a role model by demonstrating high professional integrity, maintaining clear professional boundaries, and upholding the commercial confidentiality of Right There's work at all times

Business Development & Growth

- In collaboration with subject matter experts (Heads of Service) develop and maintain a strong understanding of current / future opportunities shaped by either the external environment or policy landscape to ensure Right There takes appropriate actions
- Report and advise on development potential together with future opportunities and risks through robust business cases and relevant cost/benefit analysis
- Identify ,develop and implement CRM solution for Right There income generation and contract management in collaboration with programme delivery colleagues across the organisation

Contracts, Bids & Tendering

- Lead the submission of high-quality tenders and funding bids (both contract and non-contract)
 that effectively demonstrate Right There's expertise and value as a service provider
- Project manage all aspects of the tendering process, working closely with the Director of Programmes and operational colleagues, while providing a customer-focused internal consultancy service throughout the commissioning and procurement process
- Implement robust systems and procedures to assess and evaluate tender opportunities and ensure the effective preparation and submission of bids
- Develop and maintain a contract register and tracking system, leveraging technology to monitor contracts and support strategic decision-making
- Maintain a full audit trail for all projects and working with operational colleagues to ensure effective contract implementation, management and compliance
- Lead cross-functional reflection and learning sessions to analyse post-bid outcomes, applying insights to enhance processes, content, and organisational competitiveness
- Represent Right There effectively at all stages of public sector commissioning and procurement cycles
- Oversee the timely preparation and submission of monitoring reports for commissioners and external funders, ensuring a consistent approach to submissions that effectively showcase the potential impact of Right There's programmes and interventions, aligned with agreed targets
- Ensure the Contracts and Tendering Manager keeps abreast of current / future opportunities through the regular and ongoing review of commissioning portals, horizon scanning, prospecting tools and tendering notifications and delivers to agreed timescales

Fundraising

- Develop and implement a comprehensive fundraising strategy to create a sustainable and growing income stream
- Design bespoke donor engagement, stewardship, and retention strategies across all donor segments, including major donors, trusts & foundations, corporate partnerships, events, and individual giving
- Oversee and foster all fundraising initiatives and campaigns to achieve agreed income targets and increase volunteer engagement

- Lead the organisation's internal and external communications, ensuring a clear, engaging, and consistent brand presence across all channels
- Be accountable for all communication messaging, working closely with the Communications Agency and in-house Communications Lead to maintain the organisation's brand, tone of voice, and positive style
- Ensure fundraising and programme activities are effectively promoted and aligned with Right There's overall messaging and brand strategy
- Foster engagement and connectivity across the organisation by leveraging a diverse range of communication tools, channels, and measurement approaches to engage employees and volunteers

- Identify, establish, and nurture strategic relationships aligned with Right There's organisational goals to secure long-term, sustainable support
- Work cross-functionally to develop strong internal relationships, ensuring diverse perspectives are integrated into strategic planning

Team Leadership
