The Role:

You will have experience of working with young people, preferably in an outdoor setting. Your role will include taking responsibility for organising and delivering, programmes of self-discovery and outdoor nature-based activities. You will lead and coordinate activities designed to develop young leaders' confidence, life skills and promote positive destinations.

You will develop programmes alongside staff and volunteers for small groups of young people aged between 12 to 24 at Threipmuir Farm Steading and in the local community.

Duties:

- Delivering programmes, wilderness/biodiversity activities, arts-based activities, community/environmental projects
- Supporting and developing of the Young Leaders, coordinate regular meetings and training
- Support the development of SMART Goals/future positive outcomes
- Delivering and Co-ordinating youth awards and accreditations, liaising with awarding bodies/external agencies
- Assessing the needs of young people, and planning and delivering the programme
- Plan and organise activities, in conjunction with young people
- Working closely with Youth Vision Staff, attending regular meetings
- Provide support and advice to young people experiencing difficulties, such as family breakdown, mental health conditions, unemployment, drug abuse and homelessness
- Assess risks and ensure Health and Safety Procedures are followed.
- Work closely with teachers, other professionals and local authorities.
- Organise, alongside the Senior Youth Development Worker, the roster of staff/ volunteers to deliver programs and collect & return young people
- Organise on-site induction training for new volunteers and provide continuing support and
