Job Purpose

- The Live Music Coordinator will arrange live music experiences across the UK, improving the health and wellbeing of children and adults through the healing power of live music.
- The Live Music Coordinator works with our professional musicians to share live music with people who may not otherwise get to experience it, organising programmes with partner organisations, in line with the organisation's strategy and operational plan.
- The Live Music Coordinator supports delivery of the annual programme of live music experiences communicating with hospitals, hospices, care homes and the community. This includes those living with dementia, who have mental health problems, or who are seriously ill.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Coordination of the live music programme in line with strategic aims and objectives under guidance from the Live Music Development Managers.
- Support the Fundraising and Communications team as per the reporting timeframes required by providing information on relevant live music
- Inform the Live Music Development Managers of progress and developments in the live music programme.
- Support the Live Music Development Managers to manage and deliver services within the available service delivery budget, including the negotiation and agreement of financial contributions from health and care settings
- Encourage and monitor feedback from healthcare centres, participants and musicians
- Live music administration using the Beacon CRM, including creating and updating records, and sending live music confirmations to musicians and settings, ensuring all details are correctly entered in the system.

- Identify stories and opportunities for press, media and our resources
- Support Safeguarding and Health and Safety compliance for live music sessions.
- Represent the charity to develop and grow relationships, building strong connections with setting staff and musicians
- Contribute to UK-wide activities including funder events and promotional tasks or engagements as required.

Quality Assurance and working with Musicians

- Assessing musician(s) standards and monitoring quality of delivery
- Working with the team to ensure in depth knowledge of musician base
- Supporting the Live Music Development Managers to facilitate Musicians' Engagement and Development activities as required
- Supporting musician recruitment, audition and induction processes

General
