Growing Organic Zucchini in the Urban Backyard - Design Document

Business Purpose	Gregg's Garden Center provides a wide variety of plants and products for plant care and garden landscaping. A significant number of customers grow organic vegetables at home. Sales associates have struggled to sell products needed to successfully grow organic zucchini and have not been able to answer customer questions about growing zucchini organically in the limited space of urban backyards. The goal is to educate sales associates on how to grow organic zucchini in limited spaces so they can provide customers with setup and care product options as they answer customer questions, which will ultimately increase sales.
Target Audience	Sales Associates that directly work with customers answering questions and providing product suggestions. Both new and current sales associates will complete this training once and then as a refresher course when needed.
Training Time	30 minutes – Training time is based on the complexity of the course content and giving the learner time to complete both formative and summative assessments.
Training Recommendation	 1 eLearning course to allow sales associates to complete training at different times to limit disruption to the company's work schedule and customer service.
