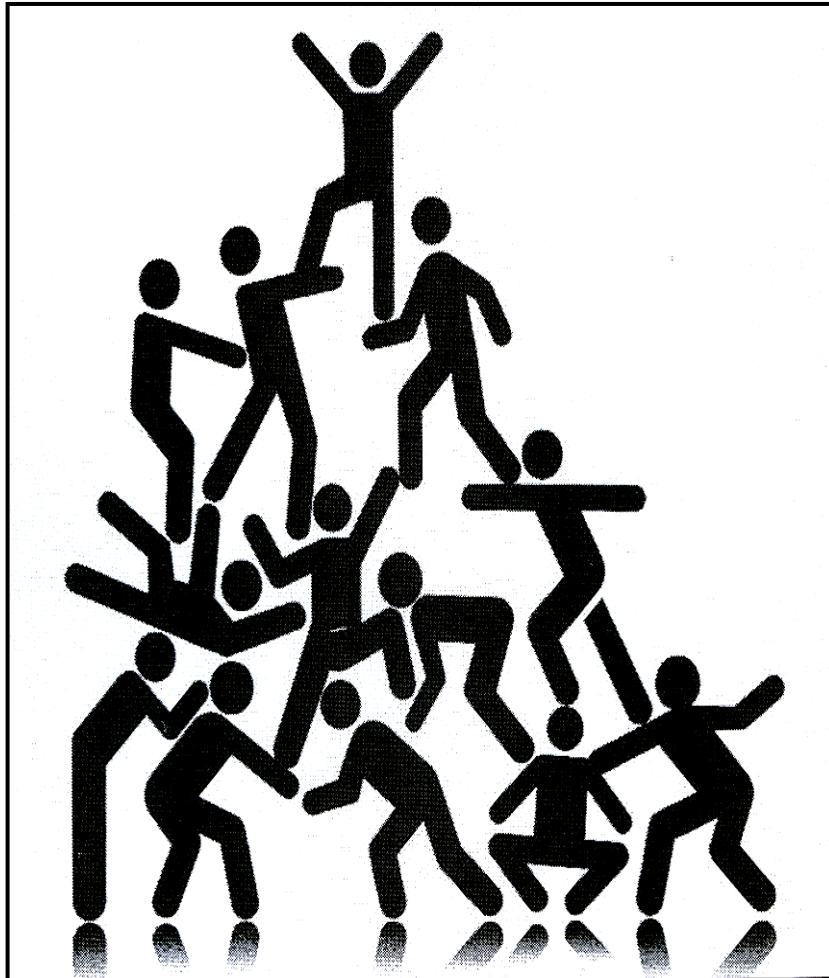


1.7 The pictures reproduced below may evoke a reaction or feeling in you or stir your imagination.
