

Greetings, dear friend

This book is designed to enhance your celebration of the Christmas message. It's to be used with 13 Christmas ornaments of your choosing.

You can make these ornaments yourself or with your children. Be creative and design them however you want. Just be sure to follow the order of Jesus's names in this book. Each name builds upon the previous one to help your family understand who Jesus is from prophecy to present.

From December 13th to the 25th, hang the next ornament on your Christmas tree, read the supporting Scripture, discuss what this name of Jesus means to you, and close in prayer.





The closer you get to December 25th, the more you'll understand about the love, purpose, and care God has for His children.

My prayer is for Christ to be the center of your hearts and home this Christmas. May you have a glorious time celebrating and honoring the God who sent His only begotten Son because of His great love for you. Let each day bring an increased awareness and awe of vour wonderful Lord and Savior. Jesus Christ, Look forward to Christmas and remember that God became flesh and lived among us. Today He lives in us by the Holy Spirit, and one day soon He will return.



To prepare your heart for Christmas, begin by reading the Bible verses about Jesus Christ out loud. All Scripture is taken from the New Living Translation.

Hold the ornament for the day, and read aloud the Scripture reference from the Bible or this book. Have older children take turns reading and look for the name in the Scripture that the ornament displays.

Hang the ornament on the tree in a place where the name can be seen. Talk about what that name of Jesus means in your life today or how or how focusing more on it can help you in life.









Close each time with your own prayer focusing on the name or use the prayer in this book or both.

Continue daily until

December 25th. On that day, you might want to see how many of the names each person remembers by heart.



Jesus

He is the **Rock**; His deeds are perfect. Everything He does is just and fair. He is a faithful God who does no wrong; how just and upright He is!


1 Corinthians 10:1-4



John 6:33-35






John 19:19
