



Correct placement of images on your workspace


How to get a full bleed print



How to get an even border all around the image



How to place the images on a double-page spread



You can fit the image to bleed: make sure that it stays within the guides (at the appropriate distance) on the other sides. The image will be fully printed.



The images must have a **minimum distance of 0.4-0.6 in** from the guides and from the central line.



You can fit an image to the central line that divides the two spread pages. However, the real crease could be placed **0.04-0.08 in** to the left or to the right of the line. This value may change for every spread (double page).

PLEASE NOTE:

The trim of every spread has a maximum tolerance of 0.28 inches per side (the value may not be equal on all sides)
