Information on data protection:

If you have any questions in relation to data protection, please do not hesitate to contact us. We expressly state that your data shall not be sent to third parties. We shall store your data in acceptance of your interest in information until we receive information to the contrary, in particular a revocation on your part. Your rights under the GDPR are as follows: Right to information on processing and further information (Art. 15 GDPR), right to rectification of incorrect or incomplete data (Art. 16 GDPR), right to erasure of data, e.g. after withdrawal of consent (Art. 17 GDPR), right to restriction of processing in cases of Art. 18 GDPR, e.g. in the event of revocation, right to withdraw consent (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR), right to data portability, i.e. right to receive your data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format for the purpose of unhindered transmission to another controller (Art. 20 GDPR), right to lodge a complaint with our data protection officer, right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority (at one's habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement), if you suspect an infringement of the GDPR (Art. 77 GDPR).

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
