

Google Cloud Event Terms & Conditions for Accelerate 2023

Event Access

- Access to Google Cloud Accelerate 2023 is at no cost for invited Googlers.
- Access includes two days of digital conference sessions (January 11-12, 2023 in region), access to any entertainment portions, and access to morning keynote addresses.
- Access is for the two-day program. Access is granted only to the original registrant and is non-transferable.
- Access to Accelerate may not be sold, bartered, auctioned, or transferred in any way, and doing so may result in Google rendering the ticket null and void without any responsibility to Google. The individual that registers for the program, must be the person that attends the program.

Confidentiality

- **All of the content related to and presented at Accelerate is considered Confidential.** By registering to attend Accelerate, you agree to keep all information related to Accelerate confidential and not share that information outside the context of your Accelerate attendance.

General Registration Terms

- All information entered into the registration form must be correct and accurate to the best of your knowledge. All information must be entered in English. Some of the information entered (such as name, company, and the photo you upload), will be displayed for optional networking activities.
- Attendance at Accelerate23 is not allowed by the following:
 - Residents of embargoed countries,
 - Individuals ordinarily resident in embargoed countries, or

- Individuals otherwise prohibited by applicable export controls and sanctions programs,
 - Individuals under 18 years of age
- Attendees can request to cancel their registration or delete their registration profile from Google's event database by emailing support@accelerate23.io
- You and/or your company may be eligible to receive an overview of your participation in Accelerate23: for instance, the most-attended sessions or topics of interest. By registering for Accelerate23, you consent to the use of your attendance and registration information for this purpose.

Your Attendee Information

- As you know, the information presented at Accelerate is CONFIDENTIAL. Therefore, photography, video and any sharing of information related to Accelerate is not allowed. Confidentiality will be strictly enforced. If you violate this policy you may be asked to remove posts or exit the digital conference and your access to Accelerate may be revoked.

Marketing Release

- Google may document the Accelerate program. Photographs, audio and/or video recorded by Google, or others on behalf of Google, at Accelerate may include your name, company name, voice, image or likeness.
