

Google Cloud Accelerate Roadshow 2027 Event Terms & Conditions

Event Access

- Access to Google Cloud Accelerate (“Accelerate”) is at no cost for invited Googlers.
- Access includes two days of in-person programming at one assigned location in January or February 2027.
- Access is granted to the original registrant only and is non-transferable.
- Access to Accelerate may not be sold, bartered, auctioned, or transferred in any way, and any attempt to do so may result in Google rendering the ticket null and void without any liability to Google. As the individual Googler that registers for the program, you must be the person that attends the program.

Confidentiality

- All of the content presented at Accelerate is confidential. By registering to attend Accelerate, you agree to keep all information presented at Accelerate confidential and not share that information outside the context of your Accelerate attendance. This includes photographs, copies or other reprints and representations of or including such information.
- In addition, the gathering and information sharing that takes place at Accelerate can raise safety and public disclosure concerns. For this reason, you agree not to share, publicly disclose or post any photos, videos or other information about Accelerate, including its occurrence, location or activities, other than within Google, until at least one day after the event concludes, whether or not such content is independently confidential.

General Registration Terms

- All information entered into the registration form must be correct and accurate to the best of your knowledge. All information must be entered in English. Some of the information entered (such as name, company, and the photo you upload), will be displayed for optional networking activities.
- The following individuals are prohibited from attending Accelerate:
 - Residents of U.S. embargoed countries,
 - Individuals who ordinarily reside in U.S. embargoed countries,
 - Individuals otherwise prohibited by applicable export controls or sanctions programs, and
 - Individuals under 18 years of age.
- As an attendee, you can request to cancel your registration or to delete your registration profile from Google’s event database by emailing support@Acceleratetomorrow.io
- You or others at Google may be eligible to receive an overview of your participation in Accelerate: for instance, the most-attended sessions or topics of interest. By registering

for Accelerate, you consent to the use of your attendance and registration information for this purpose.

Your Attendee Information

- By registering for Accelerate, you acknowledge that your information will be used in accordance with [Google's Employee Privacy Policy](#).
- You also understand and agree that your business contact information (name, company, title, contact email) may, in some circumstances, be visible to other attendees, and may be shared with event sponsors based on your interaction with certain event features and functionality.

Attendee Requirements & Expenses

- Attendance at Accelerate is for people 18 and older.
- Attendees are not permitted to bring guests to attend with them at Accelerate (unless those guests are also registered attendees) or otherwise share access to any of the Accelerate events or content. Google assumes no responsibility or liability for or associated with your guests. This includes, for example but not limited to, the reimbursement of any used or forfeited travel costs and fees or for any damage or loss to the guests' or others' property.
- Dependents and partners may not attend business sessions, workshops, team-building activities, off-site events or group-catered meals.
- You are required to follow all published expense guidelines on [accelerategtm.io](#).

Giveaways

- Attendees may be offered additional business courtesies. By registering to attend Accelerate or accepting any discounts, giveaways, or items of value related to Accelerate, you acknowledge that you are doing so in compliance with applicable laws and your organization's code of conduct.
- Gifts that may be available through Accelerate are optional, so it may be possible to attend the event even if you cannot accept any giveaways.

Event Photography/Video

- To avoid any violation of Google's safety policies and public disclosures rules, you agree not to post or share any content at all from Accelerate during the event.
- As you know, the information presented at Accelerate is CONFIDENTIAL. Therefore, photography, video and any sharing of information presented at Accelerate is not allowed.
- Videos and photographs of event locations without such content visible or audible (e.g., dinners among colleagues, still shots of keynote speech without presenter's content visible, etc.) would be allowed to be shared after the event concludes to the extent they

do not contain any confidential information, all as described in the Confidentiality clause above.

- Confidentiality will be strictly enforced. If you violate this policy, in addition to other steps, you may be asked to remove posts or exit the digital conference and your access to Accelerate may be revoked.
- While you attend Accelerate and its associated events, be aware that photographs or recordings taken by Google, vendors or attendees may include you.

Marketing Release

- Google may document the Accelerate program. Photographs, audio and video recorded by Google, or by others on behalf of Google, at Accelerate may include your name, company name, voice, image or likeness. By registering to attend Accelerate, you agree that Google may use such recorded content for any purpose without compensation to you.

Communications

- All registered attendees agree to allow Google and those working on its behalf to facilitate Accelerate to contact them regarding their registration and attendance, and to provide information about the event. - Participants asked to stop any harassing behavior are expected to comply immediately. Our NO TOLERANCE policy means that we will look into and review every allegation of violation of our Event Community Guidelines and Anti-Harassment Policy that is brought to our attention and respond appropriately.
- We empower and encourage you to report any behavior that makes you or others feel uncomfortable by visiting [go/myconcerns](#). This policy extends to all Accelerate-related sessions, Q&A platforms, social media, networking opportunities, attendees, partners, sponsors, etc.
- Google reserves the right to refuse access to, or revoke access from, any Google hosted event (including future Google events) at any time.  - Other than the reasonable efforts above, Google will have no obligations or liability associated with any such modifications.
- In the event of any modification, rescheduling, or relocation of the Accelerate event under this Event Cancellation or Modification Section, no advanced notice will be required where the change is caused by events outside of Google's reasonable control (including, but not limited to, acts of God, government regulations, disasters, strikes, or transportation disruptions) or due to safety, health, emergency, or other emergent issues. In such cases, Google may modify or reschedule the event immediately without liability or prior notice.

Limitation of Liability: Except as expressly determined by Google, Google will not be liable to attendees for any damages, costs, or losses incurred (such as travel or accommodation expenses) resulting from any changes to the Accelerate date, time, location, or content.
