

**VII. The Wisdom Writings - Books of Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon – The books of wisdom capture illustrations of extreme encounters with God or events engineered by Him that offer instruction and inspiration.**

The five books of wisdom do not follow a chronology relative to their placement in the canon of scripture text. The timeline of Job and its events are indeterminable. Psalms capture literature from the diary of David before and after he was king and several other authors without a fixed timeline. There are parts of the wisdom postulated in Proverbs and Ecclesiastes that offer a referendum from Solomon, most likely after he served as King, somewhat as lessons learned to pass on to others after reviewing the experiences in his life. The Song of Solomon is more likely a diary of his love interest while he served as King.
