Viewpoint Estimating 4.1.0 Release Notes

Viewpoint Estimating version 4.1.0 is now available and contains work demonstrating our commitment to integrating with Trimble solutions. We're also excited to share that our ongoing and continual effort to improve security and reliability means this version now supports TLS 1.2 encryption.

New login option

Starting with this release, Viewpoint Estimating supports the option to use an email address to log in. This option is part of the required groundwork which will support our ongoing security improvements and new features planned for the future.

- At some point in the future, use of an email address to log in will be required. For now, you may continue logging in using the same method you always have, even if not an email address.
- If you choose to start using an email address to log in, it must be unique to and accessible only to you.
- To begin using your email address to log in, enter it in the new login screen and select **Login**, then respond to the verification email.

Improved data security

Transport Layer Security (TLS) 1.2 is a protocol that secures data you transfer over the internet. Viewpoint Estimating now supports this protocol, giving you an industry-standard measure of safety for your data.

Style update

We've begun updating the look and feel of Viewpoint Estimating. Into this version, we've introduced Trimblebranded colors, which is a move toward a standardized look and feel that will match what you might encounter in any given Trimble solution.

Using our new styling standards, you'll notice the desktop icon and a few other items have a new look, but none of these cosmetic changes require you to do anything differently than before.

You can view fixed issues in the Viewpoint Customer Portal. You can quickly and easily:
