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Introduction

A standard menu structure is provided to all new Jobpac Clients. This menu structure can be copied and then modified to meet the specific needs of clients. This should always be done, and users assigned the User Specific menu, not the original. Jobpac may update the standard menu from time to time with new or changed menu items. These new of changed items can then be transferred to the user specific menu by the client Jobpac Administrator, or by request to a viewpoint consultant.

Each menu is assigned a two character code identifier. E.g. the Standard Jobpac Menu is JC. The client specific menu could be, say, JF.

Copying a Menu

To copy a menu in total, select menu option '**Design Menus**', then pick the one you want to copy, and select **Copy**.

To see all options on a menu, perform a right mouse click on the menu you want to view and take Select. This displays the menu options. All menu have a three digit menu number. A further select using **Entries** of one of these displays the specific options for that menu.


Printing a Menu Structure

Add their Userid and name at the bottom of the list, add a security level (see later), add the menu Code, and then add the Specific Modules a user has access to.

The Standard Ones are:

- 100 Business Forecasting
- 200 Finance
- 300 Projects
- 400 Stores
- 500 Payroll
- 600 Assets
- 700 Human Resources
- 800 Service Orders
- 900 System Administration

There are only 8 main options available on this screen, if more are required, use RMB and Select 'More Details'. This provides a further 8 options

There are additional options on this screen

- 1. Content Viewer Administrator
- If Yes is ticked, then this user can delete any document from the Content Viewer. Without this a user can only delete documents they added to the Content Viewer.
- Content Viewer Replacement Capability
 If Yes is ticked, then this user can replace documents in the content viewer with an
 updated version of the document.
- Enforce MFA.
 If Yes is ticked, this user must use Multi Factor Authorization every time they sign on to Jobpac.

SSO User is for later use regarding Single Sign on.



Adding New Items to a Menu


Sometimes Viewpoint make new menu options available to clients. The release notes will provide information on the new program name and any parameter information.

Assessing Where to Put the New Menu Item(s)

Review you own menu structure or run a report to display the full menu structure for the menu code you are using.

Remember, if your company is using more than one menu code you may need to add the items to multiple menu codes.

As an example two new menu options for Asset uploads were made available. Go to the Asset menu structure and decide where you want the new item to go. There is a menu called Asset Maintenance, this seem like a likely place.





Go to 'Asset Maintenance' menu item for the menu code you are using and find that menu. See Menu 670.

Menu Security

Each menu item or a whole menu can be assigned a security level of 0 to 9. Each user can be assigned a security level. If the security level of a user is higher than or equal to that of a menu item, then they will see that item, otherwise they will not see the item.

Below BOUDAM2 is assigned a security level of 4. He can only see menu items with a level of 4 or less.
