## **Release Overview**

For the 2021-R1 Release of Jobpac Connect the Jobpac team focused on the following initiatives...

**Supporting cloud optimization, and ViewpointOne.** Good Progress was made on SSO for Jobpac Connect which will give our users the ability to sign on with a Viewpoint One ID and access all our solutions seamlessly and will also give you the ability to authenticate via Azure AD with the Viewpoint One ID being available in the Azure AD Apps Marketplace. The underlying SSO work is complete and the technology is in place. We are now completing some final User Interface changes to make the conversion from Jobpac ID to Viewpoint One ID both streamlined and intuitive. Testing is underway for a multitude of scenarios and documentation under construction. We will update all our customers when the service is available.

**Supporting product quality.** Product Quality is always a focus for the Jobpac team. In this release we have reduced the defect backlog to the lowest EVER outstanding defects in the Backlog for Jobpac. Just 63 open issues at last count. This is not only the lowest defect backlog ever for Jobpac, but also the lowest defect backlog of the 4 Viewpoint ERP's that we sell globally. (Not that we are competitive!) The Jobpac team is very proud of this achievement and is a testament to ongoing quality focus.

**Key 3rd party integration with Earlytrade.** In Q3 2020 we rolled out our integration with Earlytrade for early Payment discounts. In this release we have continued to cement this integration with uplifted API's for marketable invoices. If you are interested in how this integration can save you money please do not hesitate to contact your account manager or myself directly.

**Targeted customer enhancements.** The suggestion box and customer funded enhancements play an important part in our roadmap as we want our product to evolve and be shaped in a way that makes our customers more efficient. Unfortunately we can't develop all suggestions, but we do consider them all, and prioritise as resources allow.

Accounting compliance for our customers. In this release we have delivered NZ Payday Filing updates in line with NZ IRD legislation. Changes for NZ also include changes in Tax Rate Maintenance and some changes in the way we calculate Leave rates to be more precise. We have also been talking with customers regarding the NSW Retention held in trust reporting changes and how we might enhance current reporting capabilities to assist you to more efficiently comply in terms of quarterly Subcontractor Statements. Discussions are also underway around the Payment Times reporting requirements and it is likely that Roadmap decisions will be made in the next quarter regarding possible product changes to assist. At this stage though, it is important to note, our solution for Payment Times Reporting is a process solution, and no product changes are currently planned, pending customer feedback.

Ongoing Security and Platform work... is a year round effort and this last quarter has been no different. We continue to perform pen testing and security remediation work in line with our SOC2 Type 2 Compliance to which all of our cloud construction solutions adhere to. 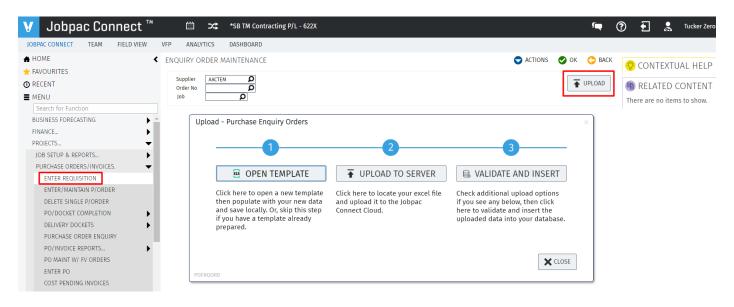

## **Roadmap**

- Enhancements to the PO Upload
  - Added additional fields:
    - Asset Work Id
    - Asset Code
    - Tax Code
    - Delivery Address Code, Delivery Address 1, Delivery Address 2, Delivery Suburb, Delivery State, Delivery Postcode, Delivery Country, Delivery Phone
    - User Defined fields 1-5
    - Included in TPR Flag
  - Display the exception/success report for successful upload with the purchase order numbers (when the order number is auto generated).
  - Allow up to 60 characters for the PO item description in the upload (increase from 30 characters).
  - Allow the purchase order item number to be left blank if the purchase order number is specified in the upload sheet. This will simplify the adding of new items to existing orders with the item number being automatically generated with the next available item number.
  - Allow the purchase order item number to be left blank for new orders that will have the order numbers generated from the upload. There is no need now to put the item number against each PO item in the upload for new orders that will have the order number automatically generated.



## • NZ Payday Filing Phase 2

With the introduction of the new ED and EI file versions in April 2020, the existing file formats will no longer be accepted from 1 April 2021.

The previous version of the ED csv file will no longer be accepted from 1 April 2021.

 A new Employee Details csv file is being introduced. This version includes new fields for KiwiSaver eligibility, employee exempt income, KiwiSaver opt-out information and new KiwiSaver statuses. The addition of the KiwiSaver fields means a separate KiwiSaver Employment Details (KED) form will no longer need to be filed whenever the new version of the ED is used.



- O New versions of the Employment Information (EI) and the Employment Information Amendments (EIA) file specifications are being introduced. These files include new fields such as hours paid and prior period adjustments, and new fields for SLCIR and SLBOR deductions so that it is no longer necessary to report those items on separate lines in the file. The previous versions of the files is still being used, however only the new versions of the files will be accepted from 1 April 2021.
- O The provision of Hours paid information by employers is not compulsory, it is requested under the same terms as employee Date of birth, in that if the employer holds the information in their payroll system it is required to be sent to Inland Revenue. There is no compulsion for employers to begin to capture this data if they do not already hold it. However, it will be of benefit to Inland Revenue and potentially their own employees if they are able to capture and transmit the data.

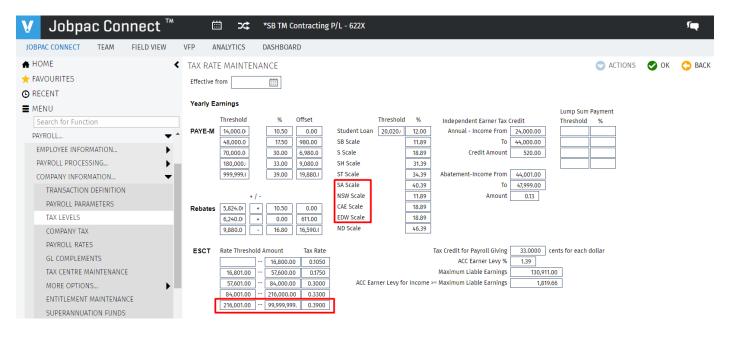
For further clarity, in the event that some or all components of an employee's salary and wages are held in, or associated to, units other than hours (or have no time unit associated with them at all), there is no compulsion to translate the data held in to hours or to calculate or otherwise create an hour value in order to transmit data to Inland Revenue. In such a scenario Inland Revenue does not expect to receive Hours paid data pertaining to that employee, for that pay

## NZ Tax Rate Maintenance changes

The NZ Government recently passed the Taxation (Income Tax Rate and Other Amendments) Bill on 3 December 2020. This was granted Royal assent on 7 December 2020. It contains four main measures, including:

- introducing a new top personal income tax rate of 39%
- introducing increase disclosure requirements for trusts
- increasing the Minimum Family Tax Credit (MFTC) threshold for the 2020-21 tax year
- clarifying the ability for Inland Revenue to require information for the purposes of providing quality policy advice.

We have included new fields as shown below in Tax Rate Maintenance to capture the MFTC. Please also note other tax scale changes to be implemented in NZ on April 1st, outlined below.



1. ACC Earners' Levy



On 6 July 2020, the NZ Government announced that it is maintaining current levy rates for the next 2 years, as part of a set of changes to help ease the financial pressures of COVID-19.

#### Therefore:

- The Earners' Account Average levy rate per \$100 of liable earnings (incl. GST) remains at \$1.39
- The maximum liable earnings that self-employed and businesses pay Work Account levies on are to remain as outlined below:

#### 2. Tax threshold and rate change

With the enactment of the Taxation (Income Tax Rate and Other Amendments) Act 2020 a new top personal income tax rate of 39% applies for the 2021–22 and later income years on annual personal income that exceeds \$180,000, as well as changes to ensure that the new rate applies consistently across other personal tax system

#### 3. Student Loan Deduction Rates and Thresholds.

Effective from 1st of April 2021 the student loan repayment threshold has increased to \$20,280 for the 2021/22 tax year.

## • Lock message on Tax Table Maintenance

Previously, when a user is in Tax Table Maintenance and another user tries to access it, their session would freeze and be locked. Now a message will be issued with the user who is locking the function.



## • NZ - OWP & AWE Leave Rate Calculation Based on Transaction Days.

To improve accuracy and flexibility in calculation of NZ AWE and OWP Leave rates.

Previously Jobpac Connect struck challenges in the calculation of true 4 weeks and 52 weeks where irregular payruns are made, either spanning more or less than the regular pay frequency for that employee. Jobpac will move to calculations based on transaction day details rather than Pay packet summary data with this release.

In addition the Leave Rate Maintenance has been upgraded to allow greater flexibility in calculations.

See the more details section at the bottom of this document for a description of changes in this area. We are advising our customers to take a copy of the Leave Rates Report immediately prior to the upgrade and then to run the report again first thing Monday morning after the upgrade is complete to analyse any changes.

## • Ability to Send Invoice Images for Invoices in Test Work Ids (Test Database)

You can now send the invoice images to the OCR email address and have them linked to invoices in the test work ids. This can be done by putting the test database name, if you have one, in the subject of the email. This test database name will most often follow the following format:

Database:JDcccTSTnn

Where ccc is the customer 3 letter code and nn is the test database number (usually 99, 98, 97, etc). This will then allow testing of OCR interfaces in test work ids including images.

#### • Default Location for OCR Invoices

A default location can now be defined to be used for OCR invoices that do not have the authorising job/location passed or cannot be retrieved with the purchase order information provided.

  - Default location when authorising information could not be populated via the OCR interface

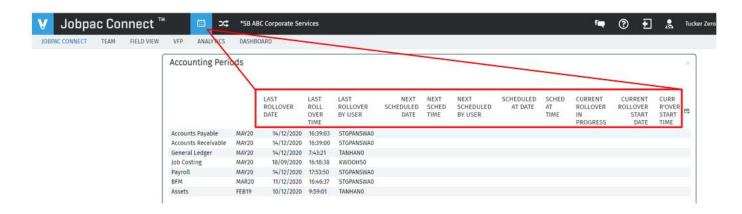
## • Convert Online End Of Month Processes to Run in Batch

The following online end of month processes will now run in batch:

- Accounts Payable
- Accounts Receivable
- Job Costing
- General Ledger
- Stock
- o BFM

All details of the EOM process will be audited as it does for the scheduled EOM processes in the pop up Accounting periods screen as shown below. It also removes the risk of a session dropping out when running it interactively and leaving the EOM process incomplete. This also completes the Allow forward posting functionality.



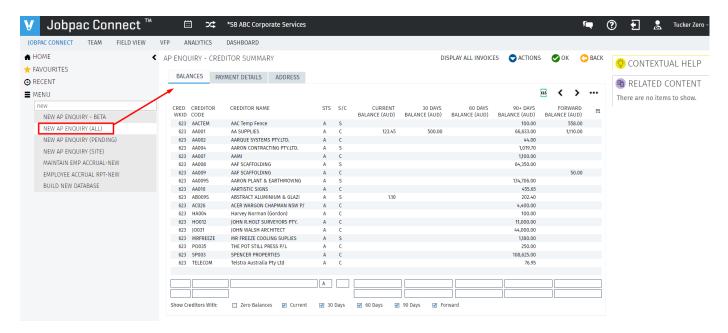


• Do not print EBITDA lines in the P&L Reports if the system parameters are not set.

Due to the recent EBITDA changes, additional lines were being printed even though the system parameters were not set. This change will now control the printing of the additional lines only if the system parameters are set.

• Enhancements to the new AP Enquiry - Creditor Summary Screen

Our New AP Enquiry beta continues to evolve as we work to modernise the old AP Enquiry to include things like Invoices coming in from OCR and Pending invoices across all Work ID's. You are welcome to start using the new Enquiry now alongside the old AP Enquiry and see how you like it. Contact us through support for assistance in setting up. The New AP Enquiry will continue to evolve and in this Release we have included a summary screen at Creditor level prior to entry into the All Invoices view.

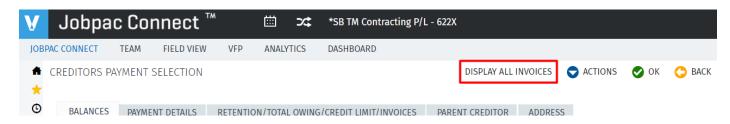


## • Convert Bulk Print of AR Invoices to JOM

Convert the invoices printed via the bulk AR invoice print to JOM. When a single AR invoice is printed, the output is in a JOM format. When printing a bulk of invoices via the Print a Range of Invoices, the output is now consistent and in JOM format. AR Invoices printed in this way can also be directly sent to Debtors via the JOM distribution functionality.

Replacing two clicks with one as shown on the screen below.





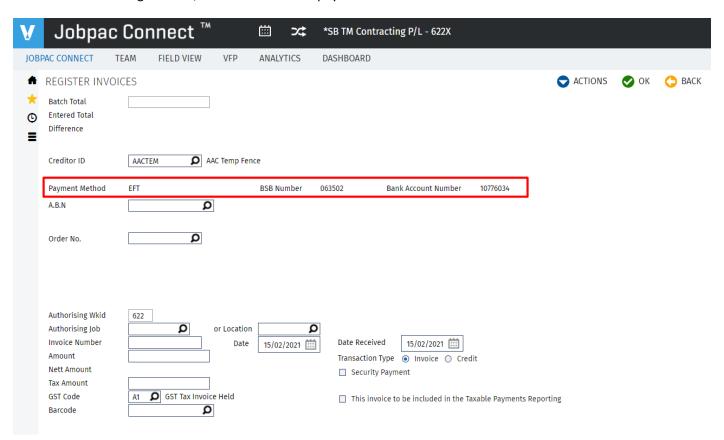
Screen Paging linked to mouse scroll - UI improvement

On Grids with multiple pages the screen paging has been linked to the mouse scroll button. It's not a smooth line by line scroll, but each spin of the mouse scroll button will page down one page (or up) It's a small thing but hopefully a tweak that will improve your experience.

  Filters are now available for every column in the Intercompany Control Parameter Maintenance.
- Show Creditor Bank and Payment Details on Invoice Registration
   In Invoice Registration, show the bank and payment details for the creditor as shown below.



• Hide the button 'Use Purchase Order Creditor' in Register Invoices

A new system parameter position can be set to hide the button 'Use Purchase Order Creditor' in Register Invoices if the Creditor entered does not match the PO creditor.

  - 'Y' Remove 'Use Purchase Order Creditor' option if different creditor
- Default of RCTI Email Address

Default the RCTI email address of subcontract agreements in Subcontract Maintenance from the creditor if not entered.

Last Used Date Filter for the Creditor Insurance Details Report

Add Last Used Date filters (start and finish dates) to the selections in the Creditor Insurance Details Report. This could assist in bulk checks for expired insurances for subcontractors that have been used in the last x number of months.

## NZ Payroll Enhancement - OWP & AWE Leave Rate Calculation Based on Transaction Days

To improve accuracy and flexibility in calculation of NZ AWE and OWP Leave rates.

Previously Jobpac Connect struck challenges in the calculation of true 4 weeks and 52 weeks where irregular payruns are made, either spanning more or less than the regular pay frequency for that employee. Jobpac will move to calculations based on transaction day details rather than Pay packet summary data with this release.

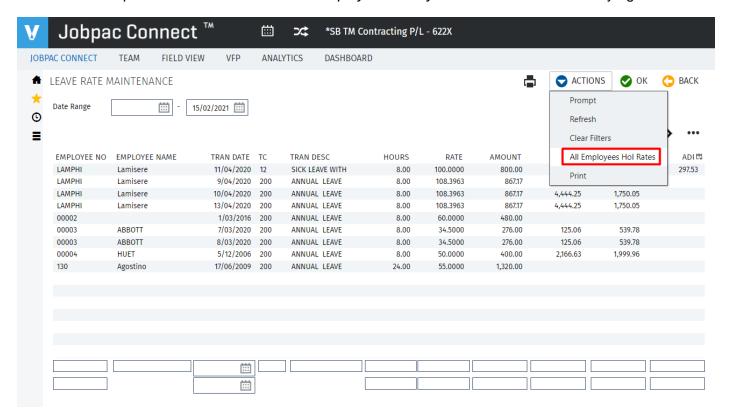
In addition the Leave Rate Maintenance has been upgraded to allow greater flexibility around inclusions, exclusions and ability to edit included hours and values. New functionality is described below.

NB: If you are using these features in Jobpac we are advising our customers to take a copy of the Leave Rates Report immediately prior to the upgrade and then to run the report again first thing Monday morning after the upgrade is complete to analyse any changes.

## Leave Rate Maintenance - Employee Current Timesheet Transactions Screen

This screen (shown below) is the first screen you enter when accessing the *Leave Rates Maintenance*Program. It will show Employees with current timesheet entries that have Leave Transaction codes and the current calculated Leave Rates on those outstanding timesheet transactions

- There is a new Action option on this screen to show All Employees and their current calculated Leave Rates. Selecting this action option, as shown below, will take you to the All Employees screen as described in the next section.
- It is also possible to drill down into the Employee Holiday Rate Calculation Details by right click.

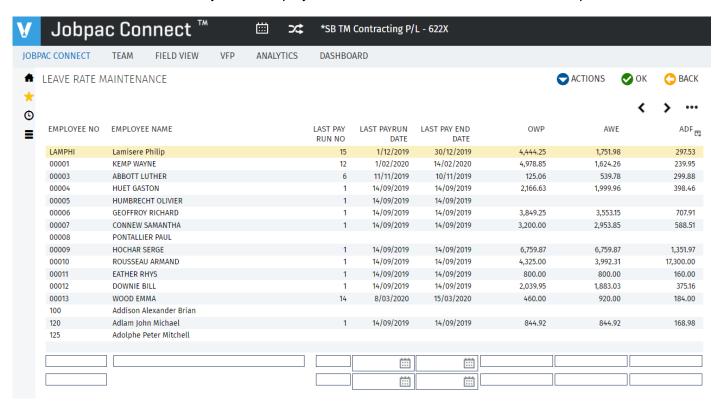




## Leave Rate Maintenance - All Employees Holiday Rates Summary Screen

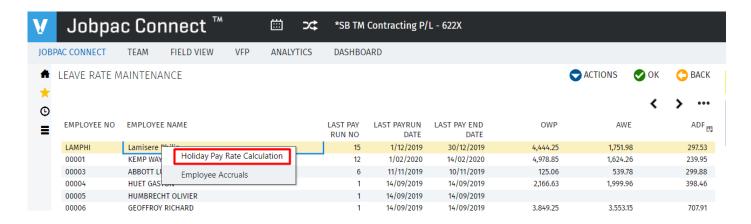
This screen (shown below) will show All Employees even if they do not have current timesheet entries that have Leave Transaction codes, and will show the current calculated Leave Rates on those Employees.

- Use Back to go back to the previous current timesheet screen.
- Use Right Click and one of the selection options to navigate to the *Employee Holiday Rate Calculation* Details screen for the Employee selected (described in next section)
- Use the filter to show only those employees with current timesheet transactions if preferred.



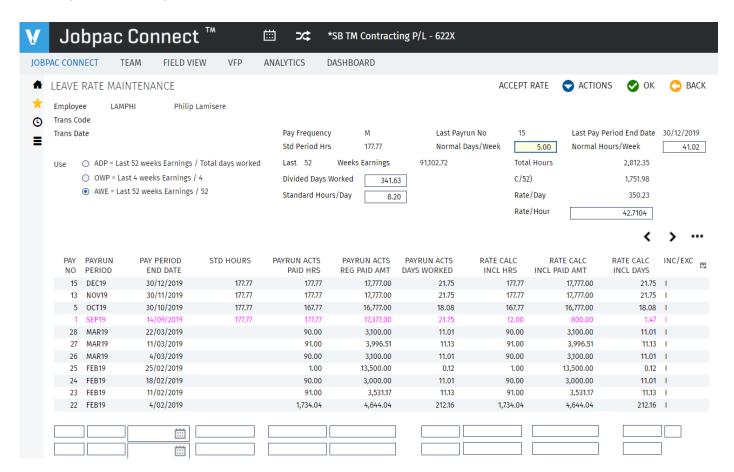
## Leave Rate Maintenance - Employee Holiday Rate Calculation Details Screen

From either the All Employees Screen or the Employee Current Timesheet Transactions Screen you can right click on any entry and navigate to the *Holiday Rate Calculation Details* screen for the Employee selected as shown below.





After Right Click and select, you will be presented with the *Employee Holiday Rate Calculation Details* Screen as shown below. On this screen it is possible to see all the "Included" and "Excluded" and "Partially Included" Payruns for the calculation of either ADP, OWE or AWE.



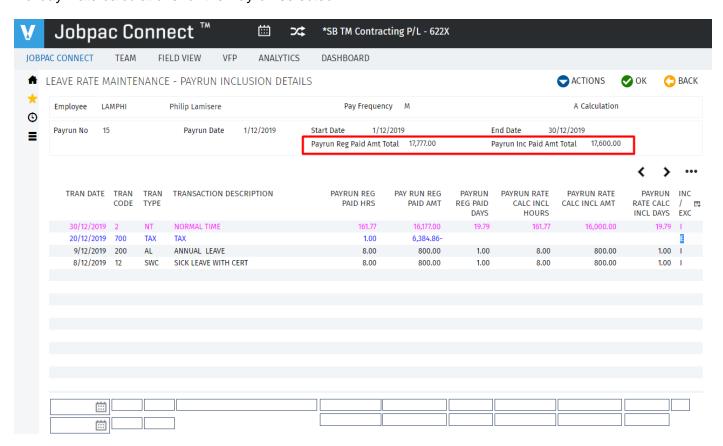
- The "last pay period end date" will be shown in top right.
- The screen will Show all Pay Runs that include a detail transaction, that is valid for inclusion, with a transaction date within 52x7 days from the last Pay Period end date. They will automatically show as Included for AWE in the Incl/Excl column on the far right.
- This screen will show an additional number of payruns, defined by system parameter, at the bottom of the report. These will automatically show as Excluded and show in a blue colour text. The system Parameter to define the number of extra Payruns to show is LRCPAY and can be set up with the number of extra Payruns to show.
- All Excluded Payruns will show in Blue.
- All Partially Included Payruns will show in Pink.
- If OWP is selected then only Pay runs that have valid transactions, with a transaction date within 4x7 days from the last Pay Period end date, will be automatically included. The rest will be automatically excluded and in blue colour text.
- Note the 3 new columns under the grouping "Rate Calc. Inclusions". The three new columns will be Included Hrs Paid, Included Paid Amount, Included Days Worked. These fields will show the included portion of the full Payrun values.
- The Inclusions columns initially will be calculated from the detailed transactions behind each Payrun, and will only include transactions with a date within the inclusion criteria back from last Pay Period end date (or the last Accepted Rate)



- If there is any difference between any of the "Inclusions" columns and the "Pay run Actuals" columns then the line will show in Pink (unless the whole Payrun line is excluded and already blue.)
- There will be a new right click selection option to select any Payrun to see and edit the "Payrun Inclusion Details" Described in the next section.
- A warning message will be shown before leaving the screen if you have not accepted changes.

## Leave Rate Maintenance - Payrun Inclusion Details Screen

This new screen will show the detail lines for the Payrun selected in newest to oldest order. With an Include Exclude on the end of each transaction line. It is designed to allow you to adjust the Included values in Holiday Rate calculations for the Payrun selected.



- Each line will have Actual columns, and editable inclusion columns that will build up to the Payrun Totals at the top of the new screen.
- Initially Inclusion values will be automatically calculated and if the user changes any values to be different from the history values the Inclusion Values will show in pink.
- There will be Payrun totals for relevant fields and Inclusion totals for the same fields in the screen header. There will be totals for the Actuals and Inclusions
- Transactions will show as excluded and the line in blue if they have been excluded by natural selection criteria based on tran date or regular pay type, or by Exclusion at Payrun level from the previous screen.
- Flagging any row as included will automatically adjust the inclusions totals and flag the Payrun as being included at Payrun level.
- If all detail lines are flagged as excluded at any time (or when exiting) then the Payrun header will be flagged as excluded when leaving the screen.



• The total of inclusions at detail level will build up to the included values at Payrun level and show on the Payrun level screen in Inclusion columns.

Leave Rate Report Changes - to support new calculation method.

The Leave Rate Report has been updated to reflect the new calculation method at transaction level.
