### Rules:

- (1) Captains are responsible to have their team ready by match time otherwise team with higher number of players present will win TOSS
- (2) S vs. G series consist limited overs format matches - 5x20 overs
- (3) Matches will be conducted on Sundays (see schedule\*)
- (4) Max 11 fielders including bowler and keeper (minimum 8 players required to play the match – 3 can be borrowed for fielding only)
- (5) Byes, leg byes and overthrows are possible means of scoring runs
- (6) LBW decisions will not apply
- (7) No Last man batting
- (8) if the match ends with the scores tied and there must be a winner, the tie is broken with a one over per side "Super Over" Each team nominates three batsmen and one bowler to play a one-over per side "mini-match", sometimes referred to as a "One1". The team which bats second in the match bats first in the Super Over. In turn, each side bats one over bowled by the one nominated opposition bowler, with their innings over if they lose two wickets before the over is completed. The side with the higher score from their Super Over wins.
- (9) **In 20 overs format, Only 3 bowlers can bowl 4 overs and any number of bowlers can finish remaining 8 overs**
- (10) **The following fielding restrictions apply:**
  - (1) **No more than five fielders can be on the leg side at any time.**
  - (2) **During the first six overs, a maximum of two fielders can be outside the 30-yard circle (this is known as the powerplay).**
  - (3) **After the first six overs, a maximum of five fielders can be outside the fielding circle**
- (11) **Should a bowler deliver a no ball by overstepping the popping crease (in front of stumps), it costs 1 run and his next delivery is designated a "free-hit". In this circumstance the batsman can only be dismissed through a run out, hitting the ball twice, obstructing the field or handling the ball. We will not have Side line no ball but guide lines will be there.**
- (12) During the tournament all participants are expected to behave professionally and avoid abusive language/gestures/question umpires' decisions. The participants must also remember to treat other players with respect.
- (13) The Team Captain is responsible to ensure all of the teammate's availability, Please consult captain for any concerns OR questions
- (14) Three "credible and responsible members" of your team should be made available for umpiring and scoring in every match.
- (15) \*Presentation and prizes will be awarded on the last day of the tournament. (announcement will be after each game)
