General Commissioner of the French National Police, Emile PÉREZ is the director of security and business intelligence of the state owned Group, Electricité de France (EDF), world's largest electricity producer (153,000 employees worldwide, 73 billion euros in annual revenue).

Just before from 2010 and 2017, Emile Pérez created and was director of the International Cooperation Department of the Ministry of Interior, gathering National Police and Gendarmerie (based in 76 countries and covering 153 States).

Police Commissioner for about 40 years in different positions and responsibilities (Intelligence, International in United States of America and Canada, Training fields...), Emile Pérez was until 2017, Head of the French delegation to the EU COSI (Committee of interior security) and CEPOL (European Police College) Governing Boards; President of FRANCOPOL (NGO gathering police training department of French speaking countries) and International Vice-President of the International Association of Chiefs of Police - IACP (2001-2002). From 1992 to 1998, he was General Secretary of the Police Commissioner Union.

He was awarded Officer of the National Orders of the Legion of Honor (2012), of Merit (2010) and the Gold Medal of Honor of the French National Police (2013).
