BY THE NUMBERS

2	Notre Dame Dick Corbett Head Football Coach Brian Kelly added two new members to his coaching staff. Marcus Freeman was hired as Bob Hinton Defensive Coordinator/Linebackers, and Chris O'Leary joined the staff as Pat and Jana Eilers Defensive Backs Coach/Safeties. In addition, Brian Polian transitioned to Associate Head Coach with his previous Special Teams Coordinator role, while Mike Elston , already the Bob and Leslie Mohr Family Defensive Line Coach/Run Game Coordinator, added Recruiting Coordinator to his title.
4	Since the start of 2018, Notre Dame is 33-5 (.868). That rate ranks fourth among all FBS teams in that time span. Notre Dame is one of just five teams who have made playoff appearances in multiple seasons.
9/13	From the 2020 starting lineups, the Irish return nine regular starters (two on offense, seven on defense), while 13 starters from 2020 (eight on offense, five on defense) depart. All starting specialists return for the Irish this season.
10	The 2020-21 Rose Bowl Game marked the 10th game in the 2020 season that the Irish played ranked as a Top 5 team. It was the most games Notre Dame played as a Top 5 team in a single season since the Irish reached the same feat in 1993. Through the Brian Kelly era (11 seasons), the Irish have been ranked in the AP Top 10 at least one week in each of the last seven seasons, and eight of the last nine.
14	A total of 14 former Irish players who saw action in the 2020 season participated in the Notre Dame Pro Day, presented by Therabody, and have declared for the 2021 NFL Draft. The full list with information can be found on Page 8.
14	From the incoming 2021 freshman class, 14 of those student-athletes are early-enrollees, and began their Irish careers in January of 2021.
19	In their solo season as a conference member, Irish football names took home five ACC individual honors: Brian Kelly was named ACC Coach of the Year, RB Kyren Williams was named ACC Rookie and Offensive Rookie of the Year, LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year and OL Liam Eichenberg won the ACC's Jacobs Blocking Trophy. In total, 18 Irish players earned 19 All-ACC honors (Williams was honored both as a running back and an all-purpose player).
41	Notre Dame has totaled 41 regular season wins in four years, the most in a four-year period in program history.
102	Dick Corbett Head Football Coach Brian Kelly has notched 102 ⁺ wins in his Notre Dame career. Ranking second all-time in program history in career wins, and with 10 wins in 2020, he totaled the most double-digit win seasons in school history (six).
511	Notre Dame has totaled 511 draft picks over the tenure of the program. No other college football program has totaled more than the Irish.

NOTRE DAME STADIUM

- Through its 91st season as the home of Fighting Irish Football, Notre Dame boasts a 361-114-5 (.757) record in Notre Dame Stadium. 2021 will be the 92nd season.



HOME FIELD WIN STREAK

- Notre Dame has won 24-straight games at home dating back to Sept. 30, 2017, starting with a victory over Miami (Ohio) and extending to the 2020 win over Syracuse (45-21).
- It continues the modern-era record for longest home winning streak for the Irish (28-straight from 1942-50). With the 52-0 shutout of South Florida, the Irish topped the previous modern streak of 19-straight from 1987-90.
- Clemson is the only Power 5 program that boasts a home streak of more than 23 games:

- With the win over Syracuse, the Irish completed an undefeated home slate in 2020 for the third-consecutive season.
- Notre Dame had not achieved three-straight undefeated home seasons since 1987-89.
- Football student-athletes who were true seniors in 2020 boast a 25-1 record at Notre Dame Stadium since beginning their Irish careers in 2017.

SPRING GAME ATTENDANCE

- Attendance at the 2021 Blue-Gold Game is limited to students, as well as University of Notre Dame faculty and staff and their families.
- All attendees will be required to wear masks and practice physical distancing. Tailgating is not permitted, and mobile ticketing will be employed.

IRISH IN THE POLLS

- The 2020-21 Rose Bowl Game marked the 10th game in the 2020 season that the Irish played ranked as a Top 5 team. It was the most games Notre Dame played as a Top 5 team in a single season since the Irish reached the same feat in 1993.
- Through the Brian Kelly era (11 seasons), the Irish have been ranked in the AP Top 10 at least one week in each of the last seven seasons, and eight of the last nine.
- The Irish have been ranked in the AP Top 10 for their first game in November in five of the seven seasons of the College Football Playoff's existence, within striking distance of a playoff spot.
- Notre Dame has been ranked in the AP Top 25 for 62-consecutive weeks, the longest such streak for the Irish since the 1994 season (124 weeks).

THE DRAFT

- Through Notre Dame program history, the Irish have produced 511 draft picks. No college football program has more than the Irish.
- A total of 572 former Irish players have appeared on an active roster in either the National Football League (1920-present), the American Football League (1960-69) or the All-American Football Conference (1946-49).
- In 2020, six Notre Dame players were drafted, marking the fifth time in the last eight years with at least six selections.
- Over the Brian Kelly Era (10 drafts), 45 players have been selected, with the most in a single year of Kelly's tenure being eight in 2014.
- As of April 21, 45 former Irish players are listed on current NFL rosters. Detroit, Las Vegas, Pittsburgh and the LA Chargers boast the most Notre Dame players, with four on each roster. Overall, former Irish are on 21 NFL rosters.

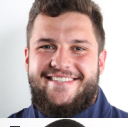
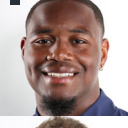
