Quick Bites

- Saint Mary's makes its first appearance in the Maui Invitational in 2021, the second-consecutive season the tournament is being held on the mainland after concerns over the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Gaels begin the tournament against Notre Dame. The two teams have not met since February 2, 1981 and have only played twice. The Fighting Irish won both previous matchups, including a 94-63 final in South Bend in that 1981 contest. Notre Dame is appearing in the tournament for the fourth time, and their first since 2017 when they won the championship over Wichita State.
- The winner of the Gaels/Fighting Irish game will play the winner of the Oregon/Chaminade game. The losers of both matchups will also play each other on Tuesday. Should the Gaels get Oregon, they are 4-8 all-time against the Ducks, but winners of the last three games. The Gaels are 1-1 against Chaminade. Butler, Houston, Texas A&M, and Wisconsin round out the field.
- This is the first 4-0 start for SMC since the 2017-18 season, when they also went 4-0 to open the year. The Gaels haven't been 5-0 since the 2016-17 season.

About Saint Mary's

- » SMC enters the 2021-22 season with the highest winning percentage (.752) and 3rd-most NCAA Tournament appearances (4) of any NCAA Division I men's basketball program in the state of California over the last decade.
- » Saint Mary's has the tenth best win percentage of any Div. I team in the nation over the last 10 seasons.
- » SMC has a 138-49 record (.738) winning percentage against non-conference opponents over the last 11 years heading into the season.
- » Over the past 11 years, SMC posted a 136-42 (.764) overall record in West Coast Conference play.
- » Saint Mary's has participated in postseason (6 NCAA, 7 NIT) in each of the last 13 seasons, the second longest streak among the 10 current WCC programs.
- » Saint Mary's has finished t-2nd or higher in the WCC in 12 of the last 14 seasons.
- » SMC has won 25 or more games 10 times in the last 14 seasons.
- » The Gaels went 30-6 in the regular season of 2017-18, marking the most single-season wins in program history.
- » Former SMC standouts Patrick Mills, Jock Landale, and Malik Fitts are on active NBA rosters. Mills won the NBA title in 2014 with San Antonio and signed with Brooklyn this offseason, Landale signed with the Spurs, and Fitts joined Utah. They join Matthew Dellavedova as recent Gaels in the NBA.

From the Last Game (Bellarmine)

Tommy Kuhse got back to his assist-happy ways, dishing out six assists to give him 367 in his SMC career, just five away from eighth place in program history...Kuhse was also the second-leading scorer behind Tass with 15...while the Gaels allowed Bellarmine to shoot 51.1% from the field, the Gaels limited the Knights to just five made three-pointers...Bellarmine was forced into a lot of errors from the Gaels defense, with 15 total turnovers leading to 14 Gaels points (14-6 advantage in points off of turnovers, 15-6 turnover advantage).

All-Conference Winners

Logan Johnson and Mitchell Saxen were the Gaels' two all-conference players selected by the WCC last season

Johnson was chosen to the Second Team, his first all-conference honor in his first year as a full-time starter. The junior led the team in scoring and averaged over 15 points per game in WCC play.

Saxen earned a Freshman Team nod after appearing in all 24 of the Gaels' regular season games and averaged 9.8 minutes in those contests. The Seattle, Wash. native was the primary backup for starting center Matthias Tass and led the team in field goal percentage at 57.7 percent.

Kuhse Keeps Climbing

Tommy Kuhse currently has 367 career assists and is ranked ninth in SMC program history, surpassing Ted Wood for that spot during the NIT last season.

Kuhse is the fifth player during the Randy Bennett era to rank among the top-10 in career assists at the school. The other four

are Emmett Naar (816), Matthew Dellavedova (768), Mickey McConnell (476), and Joe Rahon (381).

Kuhse is likely to surpass Rahon (the current Recruiting Coordinator for the Gaels) and could pass his assistant coach McConnell and jump into fifth-place (125 away from McConnell).

On National Television

While the national television schedule for the 2021-22 season is subject to change, Saint Mary's is currently scheduled to be on national television at least 14 times during the regular season.

The Gaels will be on the ESPN family of networks at least nine occasions, beginning with the Maui Invitational on Nov. 22-24. Saint Mary's will also appear on the ESPN family of networks six times during WCC play, including both BYU and Gonzaga matchups.

CBS Sports Network will carry four games this season, including three home WCC games, and the Gaels are also expected to have at least one game on the NBC Sports family of networks.

Best. Defense. Ever.

The 2020-21 Saint Mary's team finished as one of Randy Bennett's best ever defensive teams and the Gaels' best defensive team since the start of the KenPom era (1996-97).

Saint Mary's ranked 13th in the nation in adjusted defensive efficiency. No other SMC team has finished in the top-25.

The Gaels ranked second in the nation in assists/field goals made (37%) and third in 3-point attempts/field goal attempts.

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A three-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2016, 2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season.

On Nov. 10, 2017, Saint Mary's and head coach Randy Bennett announced the signing of a new 10-year contract that will keep Bennett in charge of the program through the 2026-27 season. In 2018-19, Bennett led the Gaels to their 12th straight postseason appearance, despite losing over two-thirds and three starters from the season prior.

Entering his 21st season, he is the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to 14 post-season appearances (7 NCAA and 7 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984. Three Gaels are currently playing in the NBA.

Bennett is second all-time among WCC coaches in career league wins and has a 454-192 (.704) record while compiling a 212-88 (.707) mark in WCC regular-season competition heading into the 2021-22 season. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led SMC to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament 18 of his past 20 seasons, and 11 championship game appearances. His side captured WCC Tournament titles in 2010, 2012, and 2019.

In addition to team accomplishments, Bennett has had 35 players earn All-WCC recognition, with 27 first team and eight honorable mention selections. He coached Mickey McConnell, Matthew Dellavedova and Jock Landale to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship. in Latvia.

Preseason Honors for Johnson

Logan Johnson was selected to the pre-season All-WCC team in advance of the 2021-22 season, the lone Gael to earn the honor this year. This marks the first time in his career that he has taken home a preseason honor from the WCC, and comes on the heels of his Second Team All-WCC selection last year.

KenPom and NET Facts

Saint Mary's begins the 2021-22 season ranked 42nd by KenPom. That ranking puts them fourth in the WCC behind Gonzaga (1st), San Francisco (34th), and BYU (38th).

Out of 357 schools, the Gaels have the same defensive efficiency they did one season ago (90.2) but rank 26th in the country in that stat. They also rank 22nd in opponents offensive rebounding percentage (19.5%), and 13th in minutes continuity (the percentage of minutes played by individuals from last season).

The Gaels were 60th in NET ranking and 4-9 between Q1 and Q2 games last season.

Ball Distribution is Key

Over the past three-plus seasons (including 2021-22), Saint Mary's is 50-5 in games with 10 or more assists and 16-25 in games with nine or fewer.

Schedule is Starting to Toughen Up

After the first four games of the season were played against teams outside of the top 120 in the KenPom rankings, Saint Mary's will see its non-conference schedule toughen up.

Six of the next seven opponents the Gaels will face, with the exception of the TBD matchups at the Maui Invitational, will be against teams in the top-100 according to the KenPom rankings. Notables include Notre Dame (37), Colorado State (55), and San Diego State (35).

WCC Preseason Results

Saint Mary's was pegged to finish third in the West Coast Conference according to the preseason coaches poll. SMC received 63 votes to finish behind Gonzaga (81) and BYU (72).

Logan Johnson was also one of 10 players selected to the All-WCC Preseason Team. It was his first conference accolade.

Jazz Sign Malik Fitts

Just days before the start of the 2021-22 NBA season, the Utah Jazz announced the signing of former Gael great Malik Fitts to a

two-way contract.

His performance in limited time during the preseason with the Jazz was enough to earn himself a two-way contract with Utah, appearing in four games and averaging 11.8 minutes per game. He shot 45.5% from the field en route to 3.8 points per game, and was knocking down threes at an 83.3% clip.

Fitts was a shining star with the Saint Mary's Gaels from 2018-20, spending two seasons in Moraga and landing on the All-WCC Team twice. He averaged 15.9 PPG, 7.3 RPG, 1.3 SPG, and 1.1 APG as a Gael in 68 games (66 starts). After being named Second Team All-WCC as a sophomore, Fitts was named First Team All-WCC in 2020 as the Gaels reached the WCC Championship game.

Hawaii's Ninth Island

Saint Mary's will play in this year's Maui Invitational but won't be heading to Hawaii for the tournament, after it was relocated to Las Vegas due to concerns over COVID-19.

The Gaels will play Notre Dame in the first round of the tournament at Michelob Ultra Arena at Mandalay Bay. The tournament field consists of a collection of programs that boasts a combined 137 NCAA Tournament appearances, 59 Sweet Sixteen berths, and two AP Coach of the Year winners.

Dancing History

Saint Mary's made their 10th appearance at the NCAA Tournament in 2019. Previous years at the Big Dance include: 1959, 1989, 1997, 2005, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2013, and 2017.

The team's most successful run was in 2010 when the Gaels defeated VCU then upset 2-seed Villanova in Providence, R.I. to advance to the Sweet 16.

New President at Saint Mary's

Saint Mary's announced the completion of their search for a new school president in early January with the hire of Dr. Richard Plumb.

Plumb comes to SMC after serving as the Executive Vice President and Provost at St. Thomas in Minnesota. St. Thomas is currently making the transition from Div. III to Div. I.

Plumb is the 30th president of Saint Mary's and second laymen to hold the title.
