BOSTON COLLEGE VS. NOTRE DAME - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game marks the 46th meeting between the two schools.
- Boston College is 17-28 all-time vs. Notre Dame on the hardwood.
- The Eagles are 7-16 vs. the Irish in ACC play but have won the four of the last five - and six of the last eight - meetings on the hardwood.
- Earlier this season, ND earned a 78-60 win at the Joyce Center.
- A season ago, the Eagles swept the regular season series for the second straight year, winning, 63-59, at BC and 61-58 at ND.
- In 2022-23, BC swept the season series for the first time in 26 years.
- The two teams held serve on their respective home courts in 2019-20, 2020-21, and 2021-22. BC is 6-15 at Notre Dame.
- From 1995-2005, the two teams were members of the Big East.
- BC compiled a 5-7 mark against the Irish in those 12 matchups.

HAND EARNS SECOND ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD

- One Feb. 3, Donald Hand Jr. was named ACC Player of the Week for the second time this season. He also won the award on Dec. 30.
- He becomes the first Boston College player to garner weekly conference honors twice since Jerome Robinson did so in 2016-17 and 2017-18 - and the first Eagle win the award twice in the same season since Reggie Jackson during the 2010-11 campaign.
- The 6-6 guard poured in a career-high 31 points to go along with nine rebounds in a thrilling 77-76 comeback win over Florida State.
- He drilled a career-best six 3-pointers and was 9-9 from the foul line.
- Earlier this season on Dec. 30, history was made as Hand and his father became the first father-son duo to each earn ACC Player of the Week honors in their respective careers.
- Donald Hand Sr. was the recipient of the ACC's top weekly player award on Jan. 31, 2000 while starring at Virginia.

DONALD WITH THE HOT HAND OVER THE LAST FOUR

- Over his last four games, Donald Hand Jr. has scored 104 points - good for an average of 26.0 points per game.
- Hand scored 26 in an overtime loss at North Carolina, before pouring in a career-high 31 points in a comeback win over FSU.
- He had 19 points in a home loss to Louisville before tallying 28 in a triple-overtime loss at Syracuse.
- Hand has 33 made field goals over the stretch, including 19 3-pointers at nearly a 47% clip.
- The last BC player to score at least 100 points over a four-game span: Jerome Robinson (131) between Feb. 6-17, 2018.
- Included in that four-game scoring explosion by Robinson was a 46-point performance at Notre Dame on Feb. 6, 2018.
- Other 100+ points in four games performances: Olivier Hanlan tallied 114 points over a four-game stretch from Feb. 18-28, 2015, while Tyrese Rice (104) did so from March 1-13, 2008. Troy Bell recorded 118 points from Feb. 26-March 8, 2003.
- Hand leads BC in scoring (16.2) this season and has more than tripled his scoring average year-over-year.

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Prior to the Syracuse game, the only other time Boston College had played a triple overtime game came on March 13, 1966 in the opening round of the National Invitation Tournament at Madison Square Garden. The Eagles beat Louisville, 96-90.
- In that game, Steve Adelman led BC with 32 points while Willie Wolters added 19 points and 26 rebounds.

ON THIS DATE: FEBRUARY 12

- Boston College is 13-13 all-time - and 3-5 in ACC play - in games played on the February 12 calendar date.
- February 12 marks the celebration of National Plum Pudding Day.
- Several notable events in history occurred on February 12 - 1851 - Gold discovered in New South Wales, beginning Australia's first gold rush; 1877 - The first news dispatch by telephone took place, between Boston and Salem; 1878 - Frederick Thayer patents the catchers mask; 1909 - The NAACP forms; 1924 - Gershwin debuts his "Rhapsody in Blue;" 1964 - The Beatles play their first two shows in NYC at Carnegie Hall.
- Notable February 12 birthdays: the greatest winner in basketball history Bill Russell; U.S. President Abraham Lincoln; naturalist Charles Darwin; former First Lady Louisa Catherine Adams; comedian Arsenio Hall; actress Joanna Kerns; author Judy Blume; rapper Gucci Mane.

EAGLES AMONG THE ACC / NCAA LEADERS

- **ACC Overall:** Donald Hand Jr. ranks ninth in scoring (16.2), 14th in rebounding (6.6) and second in FT percentage (.874).
- Hand is one of three players to rank in the top 15 in scoring and rebounding in the conference.
- Maxime Raynaud (Stanford) and Cooper Flagg (Duke) are the others.
- Hand ranks second in the ACC and seventh nationally among major conference guards in rebounding.
- Hand also ranks sixth in the ACC in 3-pointers made, averaging 2.3 3FGM per game. (53 total).
- Chad Venning sits in second in the ACC - and 44th nationally - in field goal percentage, connecting on 55.1% of his shots.
- Venning is also sixth in the ACC in blocked shots, averaging 1.41 swats per outing.
- Jayden Hastings is ninth in the ACC in blocks, swatting 1.22 shots per game so far this season.
- As a team, BC ranks 86th nationally - and eighth in the ACC - in 3-point field goal percentage (.358).
- **ACC games only:** Hand ranks eighth in scoring (17.4ppg), second in 3-point field goal percentage (.438), third in 3-pointers made (2.92/game), and 13th in free throw percentage (.842).
- Venning is third among all players in ACC play in field goal percentage (.552).
- Joshua Beadle is 15th in assists (3.42/g) 's 1.71:1 assist/turnover mark is 14th-best in ACC play.
- Jayden Hastings is eighth in blocked shots in ACC games, swatting 1.33 shots per game.

BEADLE'S BUZZER-BEATING BUCKETS

- Nine of the 16 3-pointers from Joshua Beadle this season have come with 10 seconds or less on the shot or game clock.
- Included in those nine was the game-winning 3FG as time expired vs. Boise State in the Cayman Islands Classic title game.
- The grad transfer guard has made 16-of-29 attempts from the perimeter this season at Boston College (55.2%).
- In ACC play, Beadle has connected on 62.5% (10-16) of his attempts from long distance.
- Entering this season, Beadle had made 9-of-49 (.184) from beyond the arc in 65 games at Clemson.

DONALD HAND JR. - YEAR-OVER-YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

- Donald Hand Jr. has shown a major statistical leap from a season ago.
- Hand is averaging better than +11 in scoring average and nearly a +5.0 jump in rebounding per game this season, compared to 2023-24.
- Using the metric PAR (points+assists+rebounds), he has seen nearly a +17 jump year-over-year and nearly a +10.0 increase when measured per 40 minutes.
- Hand has already surpassed his 2023-24 totals in points, rebounds, assists.
- After a season-ending injury game two as a true freshman, his first significant playing time came during the 2023-24 season.
- Hand was named ACC Player of the Week twice this season (Dec. 30; Feb. 3).

HASTINGS MAKING AN IMPACT

- Redshirt freshman Jayden Hastings has made the most of his three starts so far this season.
- Against Louisville on Feb. 5. Hastings tied his season-best with nine boards and logged two blocked shots.
- **So far in 2024-25, he has nine games with at least two blocked shots - the most by a BC freshman since Sean Williams posted 16 multi-block games during his freshman campaign in 2004-05.**
- In his first collegiate start on Dec. 21 against SMU, Hastings scored a season-high nine points in 29 minutes played.
- He made 3-of-6 shots from the floor and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe, to go along with five boards and a blocked shot.
- He earned the start at Syracuse, playing 14 minute and connecting on both of his attempts from the field.
- As a starter (3G), Hastings is averaging 7.0 points, 5.3 rebounds, 1.0 blocks while shooting 64.3% from the floor.
- **For the season overall Hastings is connecting on 55.4% from the floor and has logged 28 total blocked shots.**

HIGH-PERCENTAGE VENNING

- Over his last 10 games, Chad Venning is averaging 15.0 ppg and connecting on nearly 60% of his FG attempts.
- On Jan. 25, he scored 17 points (7-12 FG) in 30 minutes at UNC. Venning tied his season-high - 19 points - vs. #3/Duke.
- He had 17 points (7-13 FG) on Jan. 11 against Syracuse. On Jan. 14, he scored 19 points (8-15 FG) at Georgia Tech.
- In the comeback win over Miami, Venning tallied 17 points (7-10), scoring 11 straight points for the Eagles in the first half.
- **He ranks second in the ACC in overall FG percentage (.551); his .552 mark in ACC play is third-best in the league.**

BRINGING THE BOOM

- Boston College has registered 10 or more 3-pointers on eight occasions, including a season-high 14 at North Carolina.
- Through 23 games this season, the Eagles have made 157 3-pointers at a 35.8% clip.
- **The 35.8% 3-point proficiency mark ranks eighth in the ACC and 86th nationally.**
- In ACC play, Boston College has connected on 38.7% of its long-distance attempts - fourth-best in the league.
- Donald Hand Jr. leads BC with 53 3FGM at a 39.8% clip; Joshua Beadle (55.2%) leads the team in percentage.

IF THIS, THEN THAT...

WITH A WIN VS. NOTRE DAME...

- BC would move to 11-13 overall and 3-10 in ACC play
- BC would improve to 18-28 all-time vs. Notre Dame, splitting the season series for the third straight season
- It would mark the fifth win over the Irish in the last six tries and the seventh win in nine games.
- The Eagles would move to 2-2 in February, 8-6 in home games, 7-6 in night games, and 7-6 in weekend games
- Head coach Earl Grant would earn his 60th win at Boston College and his 187th as a collegiate head coach.
- BC would earn victory #1,284 all-time in 92 seasons of basketball, dating back to 1904-05.

WITH A LOSS VS. NOTRE DAME...

- Boston College would fall to 10-14 overall; 2-11 ACC
- BC would fall to 17-29 all-time vs Notre Dame, dropping the season series against the Fighting Irish
- BC would move to 1-3 in February and 7-7 at home
- Boston College would register the 1,112 loss all-time in program history, dating back to the 1904-05 season.

ANOTHER DOUBLE-DIGIT COMEBACK WIN FOR THE EAGLES; BC STUNS FSU, 77-76

- Boston College registered its second double-digit comeback win in ACC play, besting Florida State, 77-76, on Feb. 1.
- BC trailed by as many as 15 points - 59-44 with 12:40 to go; the Eagles held FSU without a FG for nearly the next 10 minutes.
- Minute of Mayhem: Down 70-62 with under 1:00 to play, Donald Hand Jr. converted a traditional three-point play with :48 left.
- After two FSU free throws made it 72-65 with :44 left, Fred Payne corralled a miss and went to the line, making both FT.
- Trailing by five - 72-67 - Payne logged a steal off a bad pass by FSU's Jamir Watkins and called timeout with :35 left.
- On the ensuing possession, Hand was fouled and made two FT, making it 72-69 with 30 ticks to play.
- Two more Seminoles foul shots made it a two-possession game again - 74-69 - with :28 remaining.
- Payne would strike again, converting a three-point play with 15 seconds to go, making it a two-point game - 74-72.
- Florida State extended its lead back to 76-72 after two more free throws with :14 to go.
- Payne drove to the basket and had his layup blocked, but Chad Venning tipped it in with :07 left, making it 76-74.
- Chas Kelley III stole an errant FSU inbound pass and made a 25-foot 3-pointer, giving BC its first lead since the first half.
- The 15-point deficit erased against the Seminoles marked the fifth-largest comeback win in program history.
- **Nine of BC's last 30 wins dating back to last season have come when the Eagles have trailed by double-digits.**

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT AT CAROLINA

- Boston College had one of its best offensive outputs of the season at North Carolina on Jan. 25.
- BC's 96 points tied for the second-most in an ACC game in program history; the 89 points in regulation is tied for seventh-best.
- The 14 3-pointers made against the Tar Heels tied for sixth-most in a game for Boston College.
- The Eagles connected on 54.5% from the floor and 58.3% from the perimeter: one of 16 Division I teams to do that in 2024-25.
- BC is the first team to do so in ACC play in three seasons (Notre Dame vs. Pitt, March 5, 2022).
- Since 1996-97, only 12 teams in ACC play have connected on 54% from the field and 58% from the perimeter.
- Joshua Beadle went 6-for-6 from the floor (2-2 3FG), scoring 14 points to go with six assists - one of four DI players to be perfect from the floor with at least six attempts, while also dishing out six helpers.

COMEBACK KIDS VS. THE CANES

- Boston College registered its largest home comeback win in program history against Miami on Jan. 1.
- Trailing by 19 - 32-13 - with just under nine minutes to play in the first half, BC came back to win, 78-68.
- The comeback began from there, as the Eagles closed the half on a 16-9 push to make it a 41-29 deficit at the break.
- BC began the second half on an 8-2 push, getting within four - 43-39 with 17:04 to go - after a Chad Venning layup.
- Roger McFarlane's 3FG with 8:52 to play gave Boston College its first lead of the day - 56-55 - capping another 10-4 push.
- The Eagles outscored the Canes, 22-13 from that point on - and 49-27 in the second half - to secure the win.
- Fred Payne (12), Joshua Beadle (11), and Elijah Strong (11) all tallied double-digits over the final 20 minutes.
- The previous high for a home comeback was 18 points, set on Dec. 29, 2004 as the Eagles reversed course on Kent State.

SHARING IS CARING

- Boston College dished out a season-high 20 assists at North Carolina on Jan. 25.
- Joshua Beadle led BC with six assists, while Chad Venning, Dion Brown, and Donald Hand Jr. each had three dimes.
- It marked the first time since Feb. 10, 2024 (vs. Duke) that at least four Eagles logged three or more assists in a single game.

I'VE GOT SIX ON IT

- Roger McFarlane has grabbed at least six rebounds in 31 of his last 45 games played, dating back to Dec. 16, 2023.
- He has had at least six rebounds in 70 of his 114 career games - better than 60% of his games played.
- McFarlane has grabbed at least six boards in eight games this season; BC is 6-2 in those games.
- The 6-4 guard ranks second on the team in rebounding, averaging just under 5.0 boards per outing.

QUINTEN POST STARTING TO SHINE FOR NBA'S WARRIORS

- Former Boston College great Quinten Post had a breakout game as a rookie on Jan. 23 with the Golden State Warriors.
- Post scored 20 points, making five 3-pointers, while adding five rebounds and three assists in 20 minutes of action.
- The last Eagle alum in the NBA to post at least that stat line: Reggie Jackson had 35 points, five boards, and 13 assists for the Denver Nuggets in a game against the Los Angeles Clippers on Nov. 27, 2024.
- The last BC player to tally at least 20 points in his NBA rookie campaign: Ky Bowman had 25 points to go with three rebounds and five assists with the Golden State Warriors on Nov. 25, 2019 against the Oklahoma City Thunder.
- Prior to that, the last Eagle NBA rookie with at least 20 points: Craig Smith scored 26 points for the Minnesota Timberwolves on Jan. 26, 2007 vs. the Seattle Supersonics.
- Post earned his first career NBA start on Jan. 29, as the Warriors hosted the Oklahoma City Thunder.
- The 7-foot rookie had his two-way contract converted to a standard NBA deal on Feb. 7. He had been selected to the 28-player pool for the 2025 NBA G League Up Next Game, to be played during NBA All-Star Weekend in San Francisco.

HAND MAKES HISTORY AS ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- After a career-high 29-point double-double outing on Dec. 28, Donald Hand Jr. was named the ACC Player of the Week.
- Hand poured in 15 of his 29 points in the first half and scored eight of BC's final 10 points down the stretch vs. FDU.
- It marked the first time in the history of the ACC that a father and son have each been named ACC Player of the Week.
- Donald Hand Sr. won the award on Jan. 31, 2000 while starring as a guard at Virginia.
- The ACC began its weekly awards program during the 1972-73 season.
- It is the first ACC Player of the Week honor for a BC player this season and the first since Nov. 23, 2023 (Quinten Post).
- Since joining the ACC in 2005-06, an Eagle has been selected ACC Player of the Week 18 times (10 different players).

DOUBLE IT UP

- Through the first five games of the year, a BC player logged a double-double: Donald Hand Jr. (22p/10r) vs. The Citadel, Roger McFarlane (11p/11r) vs. VCU, Elijah Strong (25p/13r) vs. Temple, Hand (15p/14r) vs. Loyola (Md); Hand vs. ODU (12p/10r).
- It marked the first time since the 2006-07 season where at least one player posted a double-double in five consecutive games.
- So far this season, Hand leads BC with four double-doubles, while Strong has two, and McFarlane one.

THE 60 POINT MARK

- Boston College held The Citadel to 60 points in the season opener on Nov. 4 and ODU to a season-low 52.
- BC has captured its last 16 games, including its last seven non-conference matchups, when holding opponents to 60 or fewer.
- Under Earl Grant, the Eagles are 21-2 when keeping their opponents at 60 or less on the scoreboard.

THE CAYMAN CLUTCH GENE

- Three different Eagles connected on 3-pointers that either forced OT or sealed the victory for Boston College in the Caymans.
- Donald Hand Jr. made a 3-pointer on the right wing with 14 seconds left against Missouri State, forcing overtime.
- In the extra frame, Elijah Strong connected on a 3-ball from the left wing with four ticks left, sealing the 76-74 win.
- Joshua Beadle's step-back 3-pointer with 2.2 seconds left propelled BC over Boise State and to the tournament title.

CAYMAN, SAW, CONQUERED: EAGLES GO 3-0 AND WIN CAYMAN ISLANDS CLASSIC

- Joshua Beadle's 3FG with 2.2 seconds left propelled Boston College past Boise State, winning the Cayman Islands Classic.
- The 63-61 win over Boise State clinched the first MTE victory since the 2018-19 season for BC, when it captured the inaugural Fort Myers Tipoff. It was the first eight-team MTE win since the Eagles won the 2003 Paradise Jam.
- Each of the three victories for the Eagles had decidedly different paths toward their eventual outcomes.
- In the opener vs. ODU, BC led for nearly 35:00 and posted both its highest point total (82) and largest margin of victory (30).
- Donald Hand Jr. posted his third double-double of the season (12p/10r) as 14 different Eagles saw action.
- The Eagles dished out a season-best 18 assists and committed a season-low eight turnovers in the balanced victory.
- Against Missouri State, the Eagles drilled 3-pointers to force overtime (Donald Hand Jr.) and win the game (Elijah Strong).
- Hand and Fred Payne led BC with 18 points apiece, while Strong added 13 points - with eight coming in the overtime period.
- Boston College logged its most blocked shots in a game in nearly two years, swatting away 10 Missouri State attempts.
- In the title game against Boise, the Eagles erased a nine-point deficit with less than nine minutes remaining.
- The game saw seven ties and five lead changes in the second half before Beadle's gamewinning trifecta sealed the win.
- Chad Venning led BC with 16 points; Beadle's 3-pointer elevated him to a new career-high in points, with 13.
- The stout Eagles' defense held the Broncos without a field goal for the final 9:00 and 24 points below their season average.
- Hand Jr. was named tournament MVP, averaging 12.0 points, 6.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists in the three games.
- Strong was also named to the all-tournament team, averaging 10.7 points and 4.3 rebounds in BC's three victories.

STRONG EFFORT AGAINST TEMPLE

- Elijah Strong registered his first collegiate double-double with career-highs in points (25) and rebounds (13) against Temple.
- Strong made his first five field goal attempts, finishing 11-of-19 on the night. The 11 field goals were also a career-high.
- The sophomore grabbed 13 rebounds, including four on the offensive glass and nine on the defensive end.
- At the time, the scoring and rebounding totals for Strong ranked as season-highs for a Boston College player in 2024-25.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR DONALD ON OPENING NIGHT

- Donald Hand Jr. logged his first career double-double - 22 points and 10 rebounds - in the opener vs. The Citadel.
- Hand connected on 11-for-11 from the free throw line, becoming the first Eagle to make at least 11 FT without a miss since Quinten Post - now with the Golden State Warriors - knocked down 11-of-11 vs. Virginia on Feb. 25, 2024.
- It marked the 22nd time since 1996-97 where a BC player was perfect from the charity stripe with at least 10 attempts.
- Since 1996-97, 97 Boston College players have logged a double-double while scoring at least 20 points.
- It marks the first time a BC player logged his first career double-double while scoring at least 20 since Nov. 30, 2022.

ROSTER COMINGS AND GOINGS

- Boston College welcomes seven newcomers - four transfers and three freshmen - to the 2024-25 roster.
- Transfers: Joshua Beadle (Clemson - two seasons remaining); Dion Brown (UMBC -two seasons remaining); Roger McFarlane (SE La. - one season remaining); Chad Venning (St. Bonaventure - one season remaining).
- Freshmen: Nick Petronio (Needham, Mass./Milton Academy); Kany Tchanda (Kinshasa, Dem. Rep. of Congo/Sunrise Christian Academy); Luka Toews (Tokyo, Japan/The Newman School). Another player - Jayden Hastings - is a redshirt freshman who sat out last season at the Heights.
- BC's attrition rate is nearly 88% of scoring, 82% of rebounding, and 88% of assists from the 2023-24 roster. BC is 20th nationally in fewest minutes returning, 25th in fewest scoring and 26th in fewest rebounding returning.

WHOLE WIDE WORLD

- BC has had at least two international players on its roster in each of the last nine - and 11 of the last 12 seasons.
- Boston College has had at least one foreign-born player on its roster for the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2013-14.
- This season, newcomers Luka Toews and Kany Tchanda are the first two Eagles from Japan and Congo, respectively.

- On Saturday, Boston College travels to Raleigh to take on N.C. State in the lone regular season meeting against the Wolfpack.
- Tipoff is set for 2 p.m. at PNC Arena and the game will air live on ACC Network, with Wes Durham and Dan Bonner.
- Fans can also tune into the game live on WEEI 850 AM, with Josh Maurer and Kevin Collins.

EARL GRANT

THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Earl Grant is in his fourth season as the Clement and Elizabeth Izzu Family Head Men's Basketball Coach at Boston College. Since his arrival at the Heights in 2021, Grant has established a culture of gritty and relentless play on the court, combined with selfless humility, a family atmosphere, and holistic development as people and players off the court.

This past season, Grant guided the Eagles to their deepest postseason run in 13 years as BC advanced to the second round of the National Invitation Tournament. Finishing with a 20-16 overall record, Grant's 2023-24 BC squad registered the highest overall

win total for the program since the 2010-11 season and the most true road victories in a season (7) in nearly two decades.

For the second time in three seasons under Grant, Boston College advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2024 ACC Championship, falling in overtime against Virginia. Grant tied Al Skinner for the most wins in ACC Tournament play by a BC coach, with five.

In 2023-24, BC was led by Quinten Post, who finished his three-year career as one of the top players in the ACC and in the nation. He earned 2023-24 ACC All-Conference Second Team honors, while also earning a spot on the conference's All-Defensive and All-Tournament teams. Post led Boston College in scoring, rebounding, and blocked shots, while ranking second in assists. The 7-footer was one of only two players in the ACC in 2023-24 to rank among the top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, and field goal percentage in the regular season. He became one of only five Boston College players over the last three decades to average at least 17 points and eight rebounds per game.

Additionally, Post was one of only three players in the last 30 years to record 50 3-pointers made, 100 assists, 50 blocked shots, and 30 steals in a single season. He was selected by the Golden State Warriors in the second round of the 2024 NBA Draft, becoming the 34th player in Boston College history to be drafted into the NBA.

During the 2022-23 campaign, Grant's gritty group tallied three wins over nationally ranked opponents, including a 63-48 drubbing of No. 6 Virginia - the first win over a top 10 team in nearly six seasons. Led by ACC Most Improved Player Quinten Post, Boston College won nine games in ACC play - the most since the 2010-11 campaign. Four of the Eagles nine ACC wins came on the road - the highest win total in away league games since 2008-09. As a result, BC and Grant extended their partnership through the 2028-29 season.

In his first season, Grant's Eagles advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2022 New York Life ACC Tournament in Brooklyn, narrowly missing a trip to the semis after a two-point overtime loss to Elite Eight participant Miami. Grant also orchestrated one of the highest-rated recruiting classes in program history, signing two four-star ranked players in the same class for the first time ever. The incoming class of newcomers ranked 30th nationally by Rivals.com and 33rd by 247sports.com.

On March 17, 2021 Grant was introduced as Boston College's 13th head men's basketball coach, bringing an impressive track record to Chestnut Hill after he turned the College of Charleston men's basketball program into a consistent championship contender in the Colonial Athletic Association.

Under Grant's leadership, the College of Charleston was one of only 21 NCAA Division I schools to have players drafted in both the 2019 and 2020 NBA Drafts. Grant led the Cougars to a top-four finish in the CAA in each of the last five seasons, including the 2018 regular season and conference tournament championship.

A finalist for the 2019 Skip Prosser Man of the Year Award, presented annually to a coach who not only achieves success on the basketball court, but who also displays moral integrity off the court, Grant led the Cougars to a memorable run in 2017-18 that included the program's second-straight 25-win campaign, an impressive 26-8 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. The co-regular-season champions earned the No. 1 seed in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship and defeated No. 2 seed Northeastern in an overtime thriller to punch the program's first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 1999.

Grant guided the Cougars to three 20-win campaigns and a 67-22 home-court winning record over the previous six years and produced 12 all-conference honorees.

For the first time in program history, College of Charleston's men's basketball was recognized by the NCAA for the 2018-19 academic year. Under the guidance of Grant, the programs' four-year rolling APR was in the Top 10% of all men's basketball programs in the country. The Cougars were one of only 51 men's basketball programs honored nationally. In all, 24 players have gone on to earn their degree at The College.

In 2018-19, CoFC posted a 24-9 overall record with non-conference victories over Rhode Island, VCU and Memphis. Two players - Grant Riller and Jarrell Brantley - were named to the All-CAA First Team. Known for their gritty defense, the Cougars led the CAA in scoring defense for the fourth-straight year holding opponents to 68.6 points per game. CoFC also ranked No. 17 in the nation in turnovers per game (10.5 avg.) and No. 16 in free-throw percentage (76.4%).

Known as a player's coach, Grant and his staff helped develop Brantley into a 2019 NBA Draft Pick and Riller into a 2020 NBA Draft Pick - the third and fourth-ever College of Charleston players to be drafted. Brantley is currently a two-way player with the Utah Jazz and was named to the 2020 NBA G League First Team and All-Rookie Team as a member

of the Salt Lake City Stars. He was second in voting for NBA G League Rookie of the Year honors. Riller was selected in the second round by the Charlotte Hornets giving the Cougars back-to-back NBA Draft picks for the first time in school history.

In 2016-17, Grant led the Cougars to a 25-10 overall record and 14-4 mark in Colonial Athletic Association play. It marked the program's first 20-win campaign since 2013. Charleston, seeded a program-best No. 2, advanced to the championship game of the CAA Tournament for the first time since CoFC joined the Colonial in 2013. They were also selected and made their fifth all-time appearance in the Postseason NIT. It was their first postseason berth (NCAA or NIT) since 2011.

In his second season with the Cougars, Grant and his staff turned the program into one of the most improved in NCAA Division I and developed four all-conference players including Colonial Athletic Association Rookie of the Year and All-CAA Third Team selection Jarrell Brantley - the first freshman to receive such honors since 2006.

Known as a top recruiter, Grant has shown impressive credentials in both identifying and developing top-flight talent. No stranger to the ACC, he previously spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Clemson under Brad Brownell, where he made a positive impact on the Tiger men's basketball program, both in recruiting and with player development. He worked primarily with Clemson's point guards.

He recruited 2014 first-team All-ACC selection K.J. McDaniels to Clemson, where he ultimately ended up averaging 17 points per game as a junior and was named ACC Defensive Player of the Year, before declaring early for the NBA Draft. McDaniels was selected 32nd overall in the 2014 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

Several Tiger point guards have flourished under Grant's mentoring including incumbent starter Rod Hall. After recruiting the Augusta, Ga., native to Clemson, Grant has seen Hall develop into one of the leaders of the program. During the 2013-14 season, Hall was second on the team in scoring average and ranked among the ACC's top 10 in both assists per game and assist-to-turnover ratio.

In 2010-11, Grant worked with Demontez Stitt, who was named third-team All-ACC and was a member of the All-ACC Tournament Team. That same season, Grant helped Andre Young to an ACC-leading 2.55 assist-to-turnover ratio. Young went on to lead the conference in steals per game as a senior in 2011-12, earning All-ACC Defensive Team honors. He also led the Tigers in scoring under Grant's direction.

Clemson put together strong team results with Grant in the fold as well. In 2013-14, the Tigers went 23-13 overall and recorded a 10-win improvement from the previous season. Clemson advanced to the NIT semifinals and was 10-8 during the ACC regular season.

In Grant's first season in 2010-11, Clemson put together a 22-12 overall record and 9-7 league mark in the ACC. The Tigers earned the No. 4 seed at the ACC Tournament and advanced to the semifinals in Greensboro, N.C. Clemson also went to a fourth-consecutive NCAA Tournament and won its first-round game over UAB, 70-52, in Dayton, Ohio.

Clemson was strong defensively in four seasons with Grant part of its coaching staff. In 2010-11, the Tigers ranked No. 24 nationally in scoring defense. In 2011-12, Clemson yielded just 60.6 points per game to the opposition, the second-best figure among ACC schools. In 2012-13, the Tigers dropped their average even further to 60.1 points per game. That figure dropped to an ACC era-best at Clemson - 58.4 points per game - in 2013-14. The Tiger perimeter defense was No. 1 nationally defending the three-pointer (.286).

Grant personally signed 10 of Clemson's 15 players recruited by Brownell's staff. He was Clemson's lead recruiter for players such as Austin Ajukwa, Jaron Blossomgame, Gabe DeVoe, Ibrahim Djambo, Sidy Djitte, Hall, K.J. McDaniels and Patrick Rooks.

Prior to Clemson, Grant served as an assistant coach first at Winthrop and then at Wichita State. He helped the Eagles to three consecutive Big South championships and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2004-05, the Eagles were 27-6 overall. The next season, Winthrop finished the year with a 23-8 overall record and came within two points of upsetting Tennessee in the NCAA Tournament. In 2007, Grant helped the Eagles to a 29-5 overall record and unblemished 14-0 mark in Big South play.

The 2007 campaign was a memorable one for Winthrop. With Grant's assistance, the Eagles claimed a 74-64 upset over No. 6 seed Notre Dame in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament. It was Winthrop's first-ever NCAA Tournament win in seven tries.

Grant was at Wichita State from 2007-10, when the Shockers made gradual improvement each season. In 2008-09, Wichita State made its first postseason appearance in three years and also defeated one of the nation's top mid-major programs in Siena during the regular season. In 2009-10, Wichita State improved its win total by eight and finished 25-10 overall, 12-6 in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Shockers advanced to the championship game of the conference tournament and also earned a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Prior to his stint at Winthrop, Grant was an assistant coach at The Citadel from 2002-04. Grant played two years at the Division II level at Georgia College. He led the school to two appearances in the NCAA Tournament and to consecutive Peach Belt Conference championships (1999, 2000). In 2000, the Bobcats advanced to the Elite Eight of the Division II national tournament.

A native of North Charleston, S.C., Grant earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgia College in 2000. He and his wife, Jacci, have three sons: Trey, Eyziah and Elonzo.
