The Forbes Era

Steve Forbes continues to rewrite the record book for Wake Forest Men's Basketball. Along with 59 home wins since the start of the 2021-22 season, which is the third most in the country during that time frame, Wake currently has the fourth-most total wins among ACC teams during that span:

KEY STORYLINES

Last Time Out

The Deacs returned to their home floor on Wednesday night, hosting Virginia. The two sides went back and forth throughout the contest before the Demon Deacons ultimately suffered an 83-75 defeat.

Senior guard Hunter Sallis led the way with a team-high 25 points. The Omaha, Neb., native was efficient from the field, sinking 10 of 17 attempts, while adding four rebounds and three assists. Wednesday was Sallis' 14th season performance of 20-plus points.

Senior guard Cameron Hildreth also had a strong night on the scoring end, totaling 22 points on a 56.3 field goal percentage. Senior forward Efton Reid III notched his second double-double of the 2024-25 season, finishing with 12 points and a game-high 10 rebounds.

Wake Forest won the rebounding battle (27-24) and outscored the Cavaliers in the paint, 52-20. For the game, the Deacs shot 30-for-54 from the floor for a 55.6 team field goal percentage.

Wake Forest in the Preseason

For the first time since the 2005-06 season, Wake Forest has been voted to finish in the top three in the Atlantic Coast Conference standings in addition to having a preseason All-ACC player selected.

The Deacs received 800 points and one first place vote, predicted to finish behind league powerhouses Duke and North Carolina. In addition to being selected to the All-ACC First Team, Hunter Sallis also received three Player of the Year votes.

The last time Wake Forest was predicted to finish in the top three with a preseason All-ACC player was October 2005, ahead of the 2005-06 season. The Deacs were predicted to finish third with Justin Gray earning a nod on the Preseason All-ACC Team.

Reid Named to Naismith Starting 5 - Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List

Senior Efton Reid III has been named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List, as announced by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.

Last season, Reid arrived to act as one of three team captains during his first year on campus. The 7-foot big man ultimately made 28 appearances with 25 starts, immediately creating a notable paint presence with leadership on both ends of the floor. He ranked ninth in the conference in both rebounding (7.9/game) and blocked shots (1.3/game) -- finishing second on the roster in both categories.

Sallis Named to Naismith Starting 5 - Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List

Sallis finished the 2023-24 season earning All-ACC First Team honors after a breakout year in the league, being named the Associated Press ACC Newcomer of the Year. That marked the first time since 2003, 2004 and 2005 that Wake Forest had a First Team honoree for three-straight years. Sallis, Tyree Appleby and Alondes Williams joined the likes of Josh Howard ('03), Justin Gray ('04) and Chris Paul ('05).

Sallis Named to NABC and Naismith Player of the Year Preseason Watch Lists

Sallis was named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Player of the Year Preseason Watch List, as announced by the NABC, and also to the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Men's College Player of the Year Watch List Presented by AXIA Time.

Sallis Named to Lute Olson National Player of the Year Early Season Watch List

Wake Forest senior guard Hunter Sallis is adding to his resume of early season nods with selection to the 2024-25 Lute Olson National Player of the Year Early Season Watch List, as announced by the organization.



KEY STORYLINES

Two Times Three

One of the recent rule changes in NCAA Basketball is the ability to use jersey numbers 6, 7, 8 and 9. Senior guard Cameron Hildreth has capitalized on this and changed his jersey to #6, after three years in the Old Gold and Black as #2. His father wore 6 while playing professionally in Europe and he wore 6 as a child, so when the opportunity came to rep it again, he took it.

Hildreth is entering his fourth and final season as a Demon Deacon, and his third season as a staple in the starting lineup (he still played significant minutes as a freshman in 21-22).

In the new age of NIL and one-time transfers, Hildreth is one of just five ACC players to be finishing their collegiate career this season at the same school they started, and as a three+ season starter for. There are 280+ men's basketball players in the ACC this season.

He joins the likes of RJ Davis (North Carolina), Ian Schieffelin and Chase Hunter (Clemson) and Maxime Raynaud (Stanford).

Building on Excellence

- Last season, the Demon Deacons defeated five teams that reached the 2024 NCAA Tournament, including three wins over Elite Eight teams and a victory over a Final Four team.
- The core of Hunter Sallis, Efton Reid III and Cameron Hildreth provided an exciting environment for Deacon Nation all year long.
- Wake Forest saw success in season attendance numbers this season with 164,931 fans packing Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum.
- This marked the highest number of attendance since the 2014-15 season, when Wake Forest hosted 174,336 fans that year.
- The team looks to build upon a season that saw the Deacs reach the ACC Tournament Quarterfinals and make a second-round appearance in the NIT.
- For the first time since 1995-97, Wake Forest has tallied 10 or more ACC wins in three consecutive seasons.
- The 34 ACC wins during that three-year period marked the most since the 2003-05 run - when the Demon Deacons had 35 ACC wins.
- With a win against Notre Dame in the 2024 ACC Tournament, Wake Forest reached over 20 wins for the second time in the last three years.
- The 65 wins over the last three seasons mark the most victories in a three-year stretch since the 2002-03 to 2004-05 run.

Impact Transfers and Homegrown Talent**Tre'Von Spillers**

- Named First Team All-Sun Belt at App State during the 2023-24 season after pacing the Mountaineers to a 27-7 overall record.

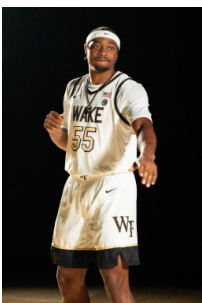

With its wins at UVA and GT in back-to-back road contests, Wake Forest secured its first two-straight road win streak in league play since the 2008-09 season.

The Deacs won both their conference home and road opener for the first time since the 2008-09 campaign.

Wake Forest won three games in overtime (Oregon State, Northwestern, Syracuse) for the first time since winning five OT contests during the 2009-10 season.

With its 98-76 win over North Carolina inside Joel Coliseum on Jan. 22, Wake Forest won its second-straight home game over the Tar Heels for the first time since 2002 (90-66, 2/6/2002) and 2003 (75-60, 3/5/2003).

Additionally, the 22-point victory (98-76) over the Tar Heels in January marked Wake Forest's biggest win over UNC since Feb. 6, 2002.

Wake Forest's 98 points were the second-most points the program has ever scored against North Carolina, behind only the 1964-65 team's 107-85 victory (1/6/1965).

When the Deacs defeated Boston College on Jan. 24, Wake Forest clinched its first four-game winning streak in regular season ACC play since the 2009-10 season.

The Deacs' 30-point margin-of-victory (87-57) over the Eagles was the program's largest over Boston College and the largest over an ACC opponent since the team defeated NC State 88-58 on February 2, 2017.

Prior to setting multiple records in conference play, Wake Forest recorded its most non-conference wins since the 2013-14 season (10).

Wake Forest reached 20 overall wins for the first time since the 2009-10 season (20-11) and 10 conference wins since the 2008-09 season (11-5).

Additionally, the Demon Deacons became the first ACC team to reach 20 overall and 10 conference wins last season.

The Deacs' five ACC road wins last season were the most since 2004-05.

2022-23 season -

First win over Duke since Feb. 2020

With the win over Virginia Tech on Dec. 31, 2022, Wake Forest started 2023 an astounding 26-2 inside Joel Coliseum since the start of the 2021-22 season.

Wake Forest has now won 13-straight games inside Joel Coliseum, which is tied for the longest streak since the Deacs won 13 in a row from March 10, 2013 to Jan. 25, 2014.

The 80-72 win over Louisville Jan. 7 marked the first time Wake Forest has won a game inside the KFC Yum! Center.

The 87-77 win over No. 19 Clemson was the Demon Deacons' second win over a Top-25 team this season. It is the first such feat for the program since the 2013-14 campaign.

Wake Forest has now started 10-0 at home for the second season in a row, marking the first time Wake has had back-to-back 10-0 home starts in program history.

Wake Forest has defeated North Carolina in three consecutive home games for the first time since the 1960s.

Wake Forest advanced to the Quarterfinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time since 2009.

2023-24 season -

Wake Forest started 10-0 at home for the third season in a row, marking the first time Wake has had back-to-back-to-back 10-0 home starts in program history.

Wake Forest ended the season 48-7 inside LJVM since the start of the 21-22 year, which marked the second-most home wins in the country during that time period.

The 17 home wins this season were the second-most in program history, trailing just the 2021-22 season when the Demon Deacons finished with an impressive home record of 18-2.

Wake Forest saw a resurgence in season attendance numbers this season with 164,931 fans packing Lawrence Joel Veterans Memorial Coliseum. This marked the highest total attendance since the 2014-15 season when Wake Forest hosted 174,336 fans.

The 2024-25 season marks the first time in the Steve Forbes era the leading scorer from the previous season has returned to the roster (Hunter Sallis).

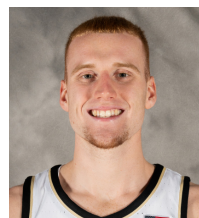

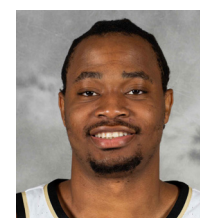

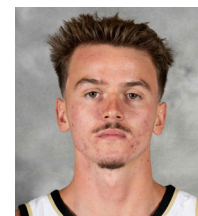

Finishing with 25 points in the team's latest showing versus Virginia (Feb. 26), Hunter Sallis reached over 500 points for this season. The senior guard is currently fourth in the ACC in scoring with an 18.6 points per game average. In addition, he is one of just two active ACC student-athletes with over 400 field goals made in his Wake Forest career, having knocked down 414 shots since joining the Demon Deacons a season ago.

With three regular-season games remaining, the Demon Deacons rank third in the conference in forced turnovers with 374. Wake Forest's opponents have committed double-digit turnovers in 23 of 28 games throughout 2024-25, including 10-plus in 13 of 17 ACC showings. The Deacs' opponents are averaging 13.4 turnovers per outing.

Cameron Hildreth finished Wednesday's game versus Virginia with 22 points, as the Worthing, England, native went 9-for-16 from the field. The performance featured the ninth time that Hildreth has reached the 20-point mark in ACC play this season. Hildreth has played exceptionally well against league foes, currently resting eighth in the ACC in scoring (17.4 ppg) through conference play.

Across 28 games this year, Tre'Von Spillers has hauled in 215 rebounds - a total that ranks first on the Demon Deacons' roster and seventh overall in the conference. Against Virginia, Spillers hauled in eight rebounds to go along with nine points. The senior forward has grabbed double-digit rebounds on seven separate occasions this season.

As a unit, Wake Forest has steadied solid offensive efficiency through league play, holding a 47.7 team field goal percentage that recently moved up to third in the ACC. The senior backcourt of Sallis and Hildreth has especially played a role in this, shooting 50.2 and 47.8 percent from the floor, respectively. Sallis ranks eighth in that area while Hildreth is 10th. Wake Forest is the only team in the conference to have two players within the top 10 in field goal percentage.

Game Notes: Email Lucy Berres a PDF of your game notes. We will make limited copies for TV crews.

Parking: Media parking is located in the Pepsi lot outside the West Lobby. You will receive a digital parking pass via email prior to the game. Visiting team personnel parking can be made available in the Operations lot directly behind LJVM if necessary.

Media Will Call / Entrance: Media members must pick up credentials and enter the arena at the West Lobby Will Call window. Media Will Call opens two hours prior to the scheduled start time.

Media Seating: Media seating at LJVM is located in section 113/114 behind the home team basket. Seats will not be assigned in the media seating area. Power and wifi will be provided.

Photo/Video Locations: Photo/Video locations are located on the baseline opposite the team benches (closest to courtside seating sideline) with limited space available on the bench-side of the basket. The LED tables on the benchside of the baseline CANNOT be blocked during the game. There will be assigned spots for photo/video on the baselines; the seating chart will be posted in the media work room prior to the game.

Photographers and videographers may set up workstations in the media work room that is through the Wake Forest tunnel and down the hall on the left side across from the visiting team locker room.

Visiting Radio: The visiting team receives three seats for its radio crew at the scorer's table next to the visiting team bench. There is a fourth seat at the radio location that can be used by an SID or administrator.

Official Stats: Wake Forest uses NCAA LiveStats.

The official stats crew is located at the scorer's table two seats down from the official scorer. Stat sheets (maximum of 6) can be picked up by the visiting team at each media timeout. Managers or SIDs may pick up a couple box scores at halftime and/or after the game if requested. Otherwise, we will deliver 10 copies of the final stat books to both locker rooms after the game.

Postgame Interviews: Wake Forest will continue in-person postgame interviews for head coach Steve Forbes and players in the press room. Visiting teams will have the option to do an in-person interview in the press room or utilize the hallway outside their locker room.

- Wake Forest Director of Athletics John Currie named Steve Forbes the 23rd head coach of Wake Forest basketball on April 30, 2020.
- Coach Forbes is a proven winner and builder of championship cultures with a 260-77 (.722) overall record in his five years as the head coach at East Tennessee State and at three previous community college head coaching stints.
- ETSU won 130 games and two SoCon championships during his tenure, while all 22 of his seniors earned their ETSU degrees.
- Forbes joined elite company in 2018-19, becoming one of just 10 active Division I head coaches who have reached the 100-win mark in their first four seasons.
- Forbes won at least 24 games in each of his five seasons as the head coach for the Buccaneers while finishing third or better in the SoCon every year.
- During the 2019-20 season, ETSU was having its best season in program history before the cancellation of the NCAA Tournament. The Bucs finished with a 30-4 record and SoCon regular season and tournament titles.
- Forbes earned conference coach of the year along with the Hugh Durham Award, given to the most outstanding mid-major coach in the country.
- During his time as an assistant, the Vols ascended to their first No. 1 overall ranking in program history in 2008 while winning a program record 31 games. In 2015, Wichita State won a NCAA record 35-straight games to start the season, earning the first No. 1 seed in program history.
- Forbes also spent two record-breaking seasons in College Station, Texas (2004-06) when Texas A&M set a program record for Big 12 Conference wins. Picked to finish last in the Big 12 prior to the 2004-05 season, the Aggies won their first 11 games and went on to a 21-10 record and an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament. In 2005-06, Texas A&M advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1987 while recording a 22-9 record, the third-most wins in school history.
- A native of Lone Tree, Iowa, Forbes graduated from Southern Arkansas University with a degree in secondary education in 1988.

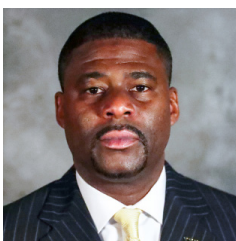

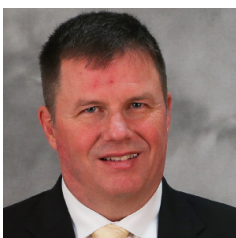
BJ McKie, a former All-SEC player at South Carolina, joined the Wake Forest basketball staff in May 2020 after coaching alongside Steve Forbes for three seasons at East Tennessee State. McKie joined the ETSU staff prior to the 2017-18 season after a 15-year professional playing career.

McKie is the most decorated player in South Carolina basketball history. The SEC Freshman of the Year in 1996, he became just the 12th player in league history to be named first team All-SEC by the Associated Press in three seasons. The two-year captain played in 123 consecutive games at guard for the Gamecocks, scoring in double figures in 111 games and collecting 38 games with 20 or more points. McKie was third in the SEC in scoring as a senior in 1999 with a 17.3 average. He helped the Gamecocks to the NCAA Tournament in 1997 and 1998 and represented South Carolina as an SEC Legend in 2011. McKie is one of just five Gamecock players to have his jersey retired after having scored 2,119 points at USC, the most of any Gamecock in school history.

Following his playing career, the Norfolk, Va. native played professionally both in the U.S. and overseas. McKie was a 2001 CBA All-Star while playing with the Connecticut Pride and spent time playing in France, Cyprus, Italy, and Israel while being named a Player of the Year in Germany.

He started his coaching career at Charleston Southern in 2011 and spent six years alongside head coach Barclay Radebaugh. McKie was a part of two CSU Big South regular season championship teams and helped the Bucs to a pair of NIT berths. He helped guide CSU to its winningest season in school history in 2015 and was promoted to associate head coach following the season.

McKie and his wife, the former Brittany Brooks, have a son Justin who played basketball at South Carolina and was a member of USC's 2017 Final Four team. BJ and Brittany also welcomed their daughter, Brielle Tonya McKie, in August of 2020.

JASON SHAY

Jason Shay joined the Demon Deacons coaching staff on June 1, 2021.

While helping student-athletes achieve their goals on and off the floor, Jason Shay is a veteran coach that has been a part of one Elite Eight appearance, three Sweet 16 runs, 10 NCAA Tournaments and five conference championships in his 21 years as a collegiate coach.

Coach Forbes and Shay spent 12 seasons working together at East Tennessee State (2015-2020), Northwest Florida State College (2011-13) and Tennessee (2006-11) where the duo has led those institutions to an astounding 315-101 overall record, which is an average of 26 wins per season.

While at ETSU, Shay coached current Demon Deacon Damari Monsanto to Southern Conference Freshman of the Year and third team All-Conference honors in 2020-21. After redshirting under Forbes in his true freshman season two years ago, Monsanto played in all 25 games with 20 starts for the Buccaneers during last year, averaging 11.8 points and 7.3 rebounds in 27.4 minutes.

In his lone season as the Bucs head coach Coach Shay was named a finalist for the 2020-21 Joe B. Hall Award, which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball. Shay led the Blue and Gold to a 13-win campaign, including eight in Southern Conference play. ETSU sat atop the league standings through the first seven games of the season as they won six of its first seven SoCon games. The Bucs defeated every team they played in conference at least once.

Prior to 2020-21, Shay spent five seasons as the Buccaneers' assistant coach under Steve Forbes where ETSU compiled an overall record of 130-42. The 130 wins are the most over a five-year run in program history and in the SoCon during that five-year (2015-20) span. The Bucs also won two Southern Conference regular season championships, two SoCon Tournament championships and made two NCAA Tournament appearances. In 2019-20, the Buccaneers set a program-record with 30 wins, becoming just the fourth team in SoCon history to accomplish the feat. In 2017-18, the Blue and Gold tied the school record by winning 16 straight games – a streak that was the longest in the country at one point that season.



ASSISTANT COACH
MATT WOODLEY

Wake Forest men's basketball coach Steve Forbes announced the addition of Matt Woodley to his staff as a special assistant in September 2020 and he was moved to assistant coach in April 2022.

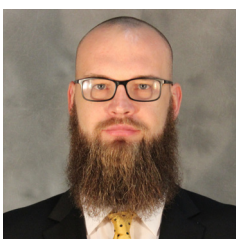
Woodley came to Winston-Salem after spending two years at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa as an assistant coach under Darian DeVries. He boasts extensive and diverse experience at the professional, collegiate and high school levels. Woodley has coached 21 (now 23) future NBA players including Klay Thompson and Hassan Whiteside in addition to serving as the head coach of the Memphis Grizzlies D-League team and an assistant for the franchise's summer league team.

As a three-year starter at Drake, Woodley played in 83 games and was twice named honorable mention All-MVC and the team MVP as a senior in 1999-00. He ended his career as the program's all-time leader in three-pointers and steals. He remains the Bulldogs' all-time steals leader with 194 and earned a bachelor's degree in education from Drake in 2000.

Since earning his degree, Woodley has accumulated nearly two decades of extensive coaching experience at nearly every level of the game. Prior to Drake, he served as special assistant to the head coach at the University of Pittsburgh during the 2017-18 season, where he assisted with game preparation, practice plans, scouting reports as well as day-to-day basketball operations.

Prior to Pitt, he gained experience in the professional ranks with three seasons on the staff of NBA G-League's Iowa Energy, including serving as the organization's head coach in 2016-17.

Woodley joined the NBA following three seasons as the head coach at Division II Truman State where he improved the team's record in each of his three seasons to amass a 38-44 record as a head coach by taking over a lagging program and leading the team to eight, 10 and 20 wins in his three seasons. In 2013-14, he guided the program to just the sixth 20-win season in program history and set a program record with 13 conference victories.



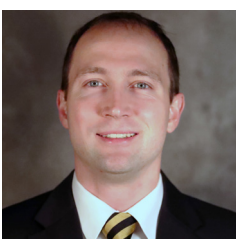
ASSISTANT COACH
ANTANAS
KAVALIAUSKAS

Antanas Kavaliauskas joins the Wake Forest basketball staff after an extensive professional career in Europe. A native of Vilnius, Lithuania, he entered the United States in the fall of 2003 to play basketball at Barton Community College in Kansas. After successful years on the court and in the classroom, Kavaliauskas earned his associate degree and transferred to Texas A&M where he finished his collegiate career with an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in 2007 and a bachelor's degree in Agriculture.

Soon after graduating, Kavaliauskas played professionally in the Euroleague for 12 years, the last four of which were played in his home country of Lithuania. He also played for the Lithuanian National Team during the summers of 2005 and 2007. His team won gold at the U21 World Championships in Argentina in 2005 and won gold again at the Universiade in Thailand in 2007. He was called up to the Lithuanian National Team in 2012 for the Summer Olympics in London and represented Lithuania at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.

During his playing career, Kavaliauskas was an LKL or LBL champion seven times and earned LKL MVP status twice. In 2015, he won a silver medal playing for the Lithuanian national team in the European Championship. Three years later in 2018, BC Zalgiris Kaunas finished third in the Euroleague.

He and his wife, Amanda, have one daughter, Alayna, and one son, Aaron.



DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS
FRANK DAVIS

Frank Davis joined the Wake Forest basketball staff in May 2020 as the Director of Basketball Operations.

Davis spent the last three seasons as the director of operations on Steve Forbes' staff at East Tennessee State after having started his career as an assistant coach at Tennessee Tech.

Davis is Tennessee Tech's all-time three-point shooting leader with 251 triples during his playing career from 2006-10. He finished his career by appearing in 125 games, the second-most in school history, and scoring 1,118 career points. Davis excelled in the classroom as well, being named to the Ohio Valley Conference Commissioner's Honor Roll four times.

As a coach, Davis was instrumental in Tennessee Tech's 2015-16 season in which the Golden Eagles went 19-12 and returned to the postseason for the first time in four seasons. Following that season, Davis was named one of 30 assistant coaches to be recognized by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) on its 30-Under-30 team.

Davis is a native of Gainesville, Ga. and a 2010 graduate of Tennessee Tech with a bachelor's degree in exercise science and physical wellness and a Master of Arts in elementary and secondary physical education in 2013.

He is married to the former Allison Price who was a three-year starter at guard for the Tennessee Tech women's basketball team, and they are the proud parents of their son Cameron.
