SETTING THE SCENE

Entering its final week of ACC action on a three-game winning streak, Stanford men's basketball travels to Notre Dame on Wednesday, March 5 at 6 p.m. PT. The action will air on ESPN.

THE STARTING FIVE

- The Cardinal is 19-10 this season (11-7 ACC), including ACC wins over North Carolina, SMU, California (2x), Virginia Tech, Virginia, Florida State, Syracuse, NC State, Boston College and Miami, including two quadrant one NET wins. The Cardinal went 16-2 at home this season and 9-1 in ACC play.
- Stanford's roster holds an exciting mix of returning players, transfers and freshmen, led by the premier center in the country, Maxime Raynaud. The Pac-12 Most Improved Player last season, Raynaud is 14th nationally in scoring at 20.2 points per game and fourth in rebounding with 10.9 per night. He is second in the ACC in scoring and first in rebounding, and his 21 double-doubles this season pace the nation. No other major conference player has more than 17 (Johni Broome, Auburn; Norchad Omier, Baylor).
- Three players are averaging double figures, paced by Raynaud but also including Jaylen Blakes (13.2) and Oziyah Sellers (13.9). Both players are posting career-best numbers by a comfortable margin.
- Blakes has showcased his clutch gene this season with game winning baskets in the closing seconds against both Santa Clara and North Carolina. Blakes made national headlines on Jan. 18 with his last-second winner against the Tar Heels, while his sister, Mikayla, a freshman at Vanderbilt, scored a game-winner of her own less than 24 hours later against Tennessee.
- Kyle Smith joined the Cardinal from Washington State as the reigning Pac-12 Coach of the Year, where he led the Cougars to 25 wins and the second round of the NCAA Tournament in 2023-24.

WHAT'S AT STAKE

Stanford has already secured a first round bye in the ACC Tournament, and it enters the final weekend of ACC action on a three-game winning streak. Stanford can finish anywhere from 4-8 in the final ACC table, and can secure a double bye with two wins, two Wake Forest losses and splits from SMU and North Carolina over the last week. Stanford can secure a top-seven seed with one win or one Georgia Tech loss.

THE NATION'S LEADING CENTER

Maxime Raynaud has been the nation's premier center this season, averaging 20.2 points and 10.9 rebounds per game, ranking 14th and fourth nationally, while also co-leading the country in double-doubles (21). His 21st double-double, coming against Boston College on Feb. 26, set a new Stanford single-season record, passing Adam Keefe (1991-92).

Raynaud is just the fifth major conference player to have at least 21 double-doubles in a season over the past five years, joining Zach Edey (Purdue, 2x), Joel Soriano (St. John's), Oscar Tshiebwe (Kentucky, 2x) and Armando Bacot (North Carolina).

He ranks first in the ACC in rebounding and second in scoring. Stanford has never had a player finish higher than third on the national rebounding leaderboard (Curtis Borchardt, 2001-02), while his scoring average is on pace to be a top-10 mark in program history. The closest statistical comparison at Stanford to Raynaud is Adam Keefe, who was 11th nationally in scoring (25.3) and fourth in rebounds (12.2) in 1991-92.

Raynaud became the program's 51st member of the 1,000-point club at Stanford, and he currently ranks 15th in program history in scoring with 1,502 points. He is 14 points away from Keith Jones '84 in 14th. He passed Dwight Powell '14 to move into the top-15, while also becoming the Cardinal's all-time leading scorer among international players. He is also fifth on the all-time rebound list (934), 10 away from Rich Kelley '75 in fourth, 21 from Kim Belton '80 in third and 39 from tying the program record. He is the fourth Stanford player to record at least 1,500 points and 900 rebounds in program history, joining Keefe, Belton and Tim Young.

He is a mainstay in France's national team system, leading Les Bleus to a gold medal at the 2023 FIBA U-20 European Championship in Greece and a silver medal at the 2019 FIBA U-16 European Championship in Italy. Raynaud was also a practice player for France ahead of the 2024 Olympics in Paris.

THE ACC'S MOST IMPROVED PLAYER

Jaylen Blakes has been one of the most improved players, not just in the ACC, but in the entire country this season, ranking 29th in the ACC in scoring, sixth in assists and sixth in steals. On the season, Blakes is averaging 13.2 points, 4.7 assists and 1.8 steals per game, making him one of just 17 players nationally to hit each of those benchmarks, and one of seven in a major conference. The only Stanford alumni in the last 30 years to post those numbers is Brevin Knight '97 (three times, 1994-95, 95-96, 96-97). Blakes also ranks second in ACC play at 90.3 percent from the free throw line.

Among all power conference players, Blakes ranks third in scoring growth from 2023-24 to 2024-25, improving by 11.4 points per game. Only Wisconsin's John Tonje (16.6 ppg improvement) and Purdue's Trey Kaufman-Renn (13.2) have more, and he is one of five that have improved by more than 11 points per game.

PROGRAM STANDARDS

Stanford is on track to break two single-season program records as a team in free throw percentage and turnovers per game. Stanford is currently shooting 78.9 percent from the stripe as a team, which would best the current program record of 76.3 percent, set by the 2005-06 team, and be just the fourth Cardinal program to shoot better than 75 percent as a unit. Stanford is also giving up only 10.7 turnovers per night, its lowest mark on record. The previous record is 10.8 per game, accomplished by the 2014-15 team. Stanford ranks ninth nationally in free throw percentage (78.9%) and leads the ACC in league play at 84.7 percent. The team is also forcing offenses to score one-on-one, ranking 11th nationally in opponent assists per field goal (41.1%, KenPom).

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Stanford finished the regular season with the ACC's second-best home record at 16-2 overall, including a 9-1 mark in the ACC. Duke is 9-0 in the ACC at home, while the Cardinal are one of four one-loss teams at home in conference play, along with Clemson, Louisville and North Carolina. Stanford has outscored all opponents at home by 12.2 points per game and 11.0 points per night in ACC play. The Cardinal locked up its best home record since 2014-15 in terms of wins (16) and since 2007-08 in winning percentage (88.9%).

THE NET RESULT

Stanford enters the matchup with the Irish at No. 83 in the NET rankings (March 3). The matchup is currently a quadrant two contest, as Notre Dame slots in at No. 103. 15 of Stanford's 31 regular season games are currently slated to be in quadrant one or two, including nine in Q1. Stanford is one of seven in the ACC with multiple quadrant one wins, joining Duke, Clemson, Louisville, Wake Forest, Virginia and Georgia Tech.

#BEATCAL

On a night when the program honored legendary head coach Mike Montgomery in front of a near sell-out crowd, Stanford completed a regular season sweep over rival California, downing the Golden Bears 66-61 on Feb. 22 at Maples Pavilion. Maxime Raynaud led the offense with 20 points to go with eight rebounds and three blocks. Oziyah Sellers finished with 14 points, including a perfect 7-for-7 mark at the free throw line, while Ryan Agarwal scored 11 points and Jaylen Blakes had 10. The Cardinal defense forced 13 California (12-15, 5-11 ACC) turnovers while holding the Golden Bears to 34.5 percent shooting from the floor.

The regular season sweep was Stanford's first over California since 2021, while the unbeaten mark could be the first total sweep over Cal since 2015. Stanford is 4-0 in the last four meetings with its archrival.

SELLERS MARKET

Oziyah Sellers has been an explosive and efficient scorer this season, averaging a career-high 13.9 points on 46.3 percent shooting, including a 39.3 percent mark beyond the arc and an 89.3 percent total at the free throw line. Sellers slots in 23rd in the ACC in scoring and he ranks first in conference games only 93.9 percent from the free throw line and third in the ACC at 42.3 percent from beyond the arc. Sellers ranks ninth in the ACC in all games at 39.3 percent from three (min. 1.5 3FG/game) and 10th in field goal percentage. Sellers is on pace for a top-five single-season mark at Stanford in free throw percentage.

CARDIAC CARDINAL

Jaylen Blakes has led Stanford to a pair of quadrant one wins on the road this season, scoring in the closing seconds to secure wins at Santa Clara (Nov. 23) and at North Carolina (Jan. 18). Stanford rallied from an eight-point deficit in the final four minutes to defeat Santa Clara, 71-69, with Blakes scoring the game-winning basket from 18 feet with two seconds to go, fading away from the elbow and sinking a jump shot. The heroics continued at the Dean Smith Center in Chapel Hill, as Blakes received the ball with just over seven seconds to play before driving coast-to-coast and hitting a fadeaway 12-foot jumper to give Stanford a 72-71 win over the Tar Heels. Ryan Agarwal joined in the late-game fun with the game winning lay-up against NC State with eight seconds left on Feb. 8, 74-73.

EXCELLENT COMPANY

Raynaud is putting up historic numbers not just at Stanford, but in the ACC. He would join a select group of players to win both the league's scoring and rebounding titles, which has only been done 13 previous times in ACC history - nine of those players won ACC Player of the Year, and only twice since the 1950s (1964 and 1978) has the scoring/rebounding leader not been the ACC Player of the Year. The last five to accomplish the feat have all earned the ACC's top award: Marvin Bagley III (Duke, 2018), Tyler Hansbrough (UNC, 2008), Antawn Jamison (UNC, 1998), Tim Duncan (Wake, 1997) and Horace Grant (Clemson, 1987).

0.7 points per game behind Notre Dame's Markus Burton, Raynaud would be the fifth Stanford player to be a conference scoring champion, and the first to lead in both scoring and rebounding. The Cardinal's previous conference scoring titles came from Landry Fields (2010), Casey Jacobsen (2002), Keith Jones (1984) and Hank Luisetti (3x, 1935-38). The last major conference player to finish in the top-10 nationally in both points and rebounds was Zach Edey (Purdue, 2022-23, 23-24). Raynaud is in contention to join Edey as the only two major conference players to accomplish the feat in the last 15 years, and just the sixth overall.

MEET KYLE SMITH

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 71-107 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 277-203 career record in his 15th season as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. He spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-00).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round. The postseason was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. They also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a bid for a second consecutive season in 2023. Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

Smith led San Francisco to a 63-40 record from 2016-19, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he was at Columbia, where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season.

AWARDS SZN

Maxime Raynaud earned four more national watch list nods in February, with selections to the Naismith Trophy midseason team, Wooden Award late midseason top-20, the top-10 for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year award as well as the Oscar Robertson Trophy watch list for national player of the year. The Frenchman was named the ACC Player of the Week for the third time this season on Jan. 27. The honor was his third of the season, which is the second-most league-wide this season. The 7-footer opened that week with a 28-point, 12-rebound performance against the Hurricanes, including a 4-for-6 mark from beyond the arc, and continued with eight points and 14 rebounds against Florida State. He was also the USBWA National Player of the Week in November.

LAI PNĪ LŪDZAM SAIMNĪCĪBĀ

Stanford announced its first signee in the class of 2025 on Nov. 18 in Kristers Skrinda from Riga, Latvia. One of the top prospects in Europe, Skrinda is rated as a top-100 (No. 92 overall) four-star prospect from On3. A versatile, 6-10 forward who attended the prestigious Riga State Gymnasium No. 2 in Riga, Skrinda starred for Latvia at the FIBA U18 Eurobasket in Tampere, Finland, where he averaged 17.7 points, 10.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists while shooting 43.9 percent from 3-point range and 96 percent from the line.

LUCK OF THE IRISH

In a series that dates back to the 1934-35 season, Stanford is looking for its first win in its fourth meeting with Notre Dame, with the meeting marking the first between the programs in 32 years.

KYLE SMITH

ANNE AND TONY JOSEPH DIRECTOR OF MEN'S BASKETBALL FIRST SEASON AT STANFORD

Kyle Smith was announced as the Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball on March 25, 2024, and begins his first season at Stanford in 2024-25.

Smith heads to The Farm following a successful five-year stint at Washington State, where he went 94-71 overall, including a 25-10 mark and second-place finish in the Pac-12 in 2023-24. Smith holds a 258-193 career record across 14 seasons as a head coach, including six seasons at Columbia and three at San Francisco. Additionally, he spent 18 years as an assistant coach with stretches at Saint Mary's (2001-10), Air Force (2000-01) and San Diego (1992-2000).

The 2024 John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year, Smith led the Cougars to a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the round of 32 with a victory over Drake in the opening round, while the postseason event was the seventh for Smith as a head coach and third with Washington State. The Cougars also reached the NIT semifinals in 2022 and earned a

bid for a second consecutive season in 2023.

Smith was the first coach in Washington State history to post a .500 or better record in each of his first four seasons, doing so after taking over a program that was under .500 in each of the previous seven campaigns.

A talented coach known for expertise in analytics and player development, Smith's tutelage has included two NBA Draft selections in CJ Elleby (2020) and Mouhamed Gueye (2023) and Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Myles Rice (2024), while three Cougars earned All-Pac-12 recognition this season. Smith also coached San Francisco's Jamaree Bouyea, who made his NBA debut in 2023, and mentored a series of professional athletes as an assistant coach, including NBA players Matthew Dellavedova and Patty Mills at Saint Mary's.

Smith has also seen success on the recruiting trail, landing two top-60 classes, the highest for Washington State in over a decade. He signed a top-100 prospect to Pullman in the class of 2022, the first for the program since Klay Thompson in 2008.

Prior to Smith's tenure at Washington State, he led San Francisco to a 63-40 record, including 20 wins or more in each season and two postseason appearances. His three straight 20-win seasons marked just the fourth time in school history that a USF coach accomplished the feat and the first time in nearly 40 years. Smith produced seven All-WCC picks, paced by two-time All-WCC first team selection Frankie Ferrari.

Preceding his time in the Bay Area, he served as the head coach at Columbia where he put together a 101-82 overall mark, including a CIT Championship in his final season. Smith mentored 10 All-Ivy League selections over his six seasons at Columbia, led by Maodo Lo, a two-time first team honoree and the second-leading scorer in school history.

Smith played an integral role in building the Gaels' program into a perennial championship contender in the West Coast Conference under head coach Randy Bennett. In his nine seasons in Moraga, the Gaels made three NCAA Tournament (2005, '08, '10) appearances and earned one NIT bid (2009). Saint Mary's averaged 23 wins over Smith's last six seasons on the staff, including an 81-20 record over his final three seasons. The 2009-10 team finished with a 28-6 record, advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Championship and was ranked 19th nationally in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll.

During his one season at Air Force, Smith served as the Falcons' offensive and recruiting coordinator and took a lead role with player development and scouting. He was instrumental in the recruitment of 2003-04 Mountain West Conference Player of the Year Nick Welch along with all-conference players Antoine Hood and A.J. Kuhle.

Before joining the Falcons, Smith served eight seasons as an assistant coach at San Diego from 1992-2000 under Hank Egan and Brad Holland. During his time at San Diego, Smith helped lead the Toreros to their second-highest win total in school history (20 in 1999-2000) and as associate head coach, orchestrated a defense that allowed the lowest opponent scoring average (62.6) in the West Coast Conference (62.6 in 1999-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record and the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot a school-record 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship.

Smith earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career.

Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo, and Luke.
