## **Australia's Ocean Art Competition**

#### Terms and Conditions

- Australia's Ocean Art Competition (the Competition) is subject to these terms and conditions.
- 2. The promoter of this Competition is the Commonwealth of Australia (as represented by the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water ABN: 63 573 932 849 (the Department)

#### **Duration**

3. The Competition opens at 10:00 am (AEST) 08 June 2023 and closes at 05:00 pm (AEST) 13 October 2023. No entries will be accepted after the closing date.

### Eligibility

- 4. Any person permanently residing in Australia from the age of 3 can enter the Competition (the Entrant).
- 5. Only a parent or guardian can submit an Entry into the Competition on behalf of a person between 3 and 18 years of age (**Child**). In submitting the Child's Entry, the parent or guardian is deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.
- 6. A teacher can submit an Entry on behalf of a class of students. The class, as a group, will be considered the Entrant.
- 7. An Entrant may submit more than one Entry into the Competition.

### Submitting a Competition entry

- 8. The Competition has one category: Show us what you love about Australia's ocean.
- 9. The Competition will have three age groups for judging:
  - a. 3-10
  - b. 11-17
  - c. 18+

# (collectively the Categories)

- 10. To enter the Competition, an Entrant must:
  - a. upload a photo (jpg / jpeg, gif, png, bmp file type only up to 200 MB) to 'Have Your Say' (the Entry);
  - b. identify the Entrants age group for submission; and
  - c. submit a completed consent form for each recognisable person in the photo. (collectively **the Requirements**).
- 11. Teachers submitting an Entry on behalf of a class of students must complete the consent form on behalf of the class, and should ensure they have obtained consent before they submit a photo of a Child/Children with the Entry.
- 12. For the purpose of paragraph 10(a) above, a photo is a picture made using a camera (including those in smartphones, tablets etc). A photo does not include a video or any image derived from artificial intelligence/computer program.

Right to exclude Entries

- 13. The Department, in its sole discretion, may exclude an Entry from the Competition for the following reasons:
  - a. The Entrant is not eligible to enter the Competition.
  - b. The Entrant has not satisfied all of the Requirements for each Entry they submit.
  - c. The Entry does not relate to the Category.
  - d. The Entry is a corrupted file.
  - e. The Entry infringes the intellectual property rights of a third party.

### Judging

- 14. Each Entry will be judged, and winners chosen by an official of the Department based on the following factors, in no particular order or weighting:
  - Relevance to the category;
  - b. Creativity.
- 15. The Department will select at least one winner for each age group in the Competition.
- 16. The Competition is a game of skill and chance plays no role in determining the winners.
- 17. The Department's decision of the winners is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the result.

## Notification

18. All winners will be notified in writing in October 2023.

#### Prizes

- 19. Each winner will receive one Ocean prize pack (**the Prize**). The Department may award up to 3 Prizes for the Competition.
- 20. The Prize is not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.

## **Provision of Prizes**

- 21. Each Prize will be sent to the Australian mailing address of the winner.
- 22. The Department takes no responsibility for Prizes which may be damaged, delayed or lost in transit.

## **Publicity**

- 23. Each winner's name and their winning Entry will be published on the Department's website.
- 24. The Entrant acknowledges and consents to the Department using their winning Entry in the Department's communications and publications or other Departmental purposes.

## Intellectual property

- 25. The Entrant warrants that they own all the intellectual property rights in their Entry.
- 26. Competition Entrant retains all intellectual property rights in their Entry.
- 27. Upon submitting an Entry into the Competition, the Department is granted a perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, world-wide and non-exclusive licence (including the right to sublicence) to use, reproduce, adapt and communicate the intellectual property rights in an Entry.

### Privacy

28. The Entrant acknowledges and consents to the Privacy Notice. This can be found on the 'Have Your Say' photo competition page.

# Release & Indemnity

- 29. The Department will not be liable for any loss or damage suffered, including personal injury or death, in connection with the Prize.
- 30. The Entrant indemnifies the Department against any claim, loss or damage resulting from, or in connection with, the exercise of the intellectual property rights in their winning Entry.

# Changes to the Competition Terms and Conditions

- 31. The Department reserves the right to vary these terms and conditions at any time and without notice to the entrants.
- 32. Clauses 25, 27, 29 and 30 survive the conclusion of the Competition.

## Governing law

33. The laws of the Australia Capital Territory apply to this Competition.
