#### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Treasury Laws Amendment (Business Registries Stabilisation and Uplift) Regulations 2025.* 

#### 2 Commencement

(1) Each provision of this instrument specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

### Schedule 1—Enhancing director ID requirements

#### Corporations Regulations 2001

#### 1 Paragraph 2N.2.01(1)(e)

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

(e) the personal details mentioned in subsection 205B(3) of the Act of each director, secretary and alternate director;

#### 2 Regulation 9.1.02

Before "For", insert "(1)".

#### 3 Paragraph 9.1.02(e)

Omit "each company", substitute "each foreign company".

#### 4 At the end of regulation 9.1.02

Add:

- (2) For subsections 1274A(3) and (4) of the Act, information is prescribed if:
  - (a) the information relates to an entity that is:
    - (i) a company covered by paragraph (1)(a) of this regulation; or
    - (ii) a body covered by paragraph (1)(d) of this regulation; and
    - (iii) a foreign company covered by paragraph (1)(e) of this regulation; and
  - (b) for each such entity, the information is:
    - (i) for each of the entity's officers who is a director or alternate director—whether the officer has a director identification number, and if so that number; and
    - (ii) how many of the entity's directors and alternate directors have, and how many do not have, a director identification number; and
  - (c) ASIC considers it appropriate for:
    - (i) a person to search the information in accordance with subsection 1274A(3) of the Act; or
    - (ii) the information to be made available in accordance with subsection 1274A(4) of the Act.
