1983 FIELD HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

TO: Field Hockey Coaches  
FROM: Field Hockey Committee  
RE: Tournament Matches / Addendum to Tournament Procedures

1. Only the following personnel are allowed in the team bench area:  
-- coaches, statistician, 1 scorer, 25 players listed and dressed on the entry form, manager.
2. There will be an athletic trainer in attendance from 10:00 a.m. until the conclusion of the third match. (Finals only)
3. Scorer, timer, penalty stroke counter will be provided by the tournament director. Two game balls will also be provided for each final match. (Finals only)
4. Once in the playing area, please confine your personnel to this area. Please notify the local news media so they will cover tournament games.
5. Each school should provide a list of ten (10) spectators who will be admitted free of charge. (Quarters, semis and finals) Use form enclosed in packet. Give to site director upon arrival.
6. Officials Fees:  
Playdowns - \$36.00 to be paid by the host school. All other fees will be paid by CIAC.
7. Procedure for postponed games -- In the event of a postponed game, the host school will first notify the Tournament Director, then visiting team and game assigned officials. Tournament Director will notify the Officials Coordinator of re-scheduled game.

Addendum to Tournament Procedures:

Check list for Coaches:

1. Reread all tournament rules and regulations.
2. Reread the memorandum to the Site Directors.
3. Protests -- refer to procedure outlined in tournament guidelines.  
\* All procedural problems i.e. uniforms, jewelry, equipment, etc., must be made prior to beginning of the game.
4. The lower ranked team must assign a non-timer to sit with the higher ranked team's timer. Although the lower ranked team will provide the official scorekeeper -- the higher ranked team should have someone assist her.
5. Officials fees:  
Playdowns -- \$36.00 to be paid by the host school. All other fees will be paid by CIAC.
