

All You Need to Know about NEET 2021 (UPDATED : JULY 2021):

NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY CUM ENTRANCE TEST (UG) (**NEET**) 2021, the National Medical entrance exam conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) has some important updates for you to consider as cited by their latest brochure.


The exam will be conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA) on **Sunday, the 12 September 2021** in **Pen and Paper mode in 13 languages**, as a uniform entrance examination for admission to MBBS/BDS/BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS and other undergraduate medical courses in approved/recognized Medical/Dental /AYUSH and other Colleges/ Deemed Universities /Institutes (AIIMS & JIPMER) in India.

The NEET (UG) – 2021 shall consist of **one Question Paper containing 180 Multiple Choice Questions** from Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (Botany and Zoology). Each of the three subjects will have two sections – A and B. While Section A will be mandatory and will consist of 35 questions, Section B will have 15 questions, out of which students will have to answer only 10. The languages in which the NEET (UG) 2021 would be conducted are : English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

- There will be no negative marking for any unanswered questions.
- Students will not be able to change their answers after marking in the OMR sheets.
