APRIL 6TH, 2022 — CLIMATE 100 LAUNCHES

With the goal of creating support for major new climate investments and climate-aligned budgeting across the budget, climate100.nextgenpolicy.org has garnered 12K views with 26K engagements. Over the course of four months, we've populated the site with 21 resources including reports, polls, letters, memos, and blogs. We've partnered with climate organizations to build a coalition to deliver content that continues to address why the California Climate Commitment is so key to fighting climate change in California.



MAY 9TH, 2022 — MORE THAN A HEADLINE BROADCAST TV, DIGITAL, & RADIO ADS AIR

Our digital ads garnered over 81M impressions with directed messaging to: Sen. Atkins, Sen. Gonzalez, Sen. Laird, Sen. Limon, Sen. McGuire, Sen. Skinner, Sen. Wieckowski, Asm. Bloom, Asm. Friedman, Asm. Gomez-Reyes, Asm. E. Garcia, Asm. Ting, and Asm. Rendon.

We teed up digital newsletter ads the first and second weeks of June in Rough & Tumble, Capitol Weekly, Round Up, Capital Morning Report, Politico, SacBee, CalMatters, and PR Newswire. They've garnered over 1M views in the month of June alone.



JUNE 8TH, 2022 — ACTION ON CLIMATE AND THE ENVIRONMENT RANK AS #1ISSUE MOTIVATING CALIFORNIA VOTERS

We partnered with Change Research to survey likely general election voters in California to find out that their top concern is climate.

We used these polls to push legislators to take aggressive action to address climate change.



JUNE 10TH, 2022 — THE HEADLINE WE WANT DIGITAL AD CAMPAIGN LAUNCH

Campaign to support historic investment in climate action earns press in Politico Playbook. Our digital ads garnered over 8K views with directed messaging to Asm. E. Garcia, Asm. Rivas, Asm. Ting, Sen. Cortese, Sen. Laird, Sen. Gonzalez, and Sen. Skinner. This was also sent in our "What's Next" newsletter email out to our climate list.

Sign on letter directed to Gov. Newsom, Pro Tem Atkins, and Speaker Rendon urges our leaders to keep up momentum on the \$54B climate budget package and includes sign-on from 23 Environmental Orgs.





AUG 5TH, 2022 — ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE & ENVIRONMENTAL PRIORITIES FOR CLIMATE LEGISLATION PACKAGE
