

It is important to familiarize yourself with your work area and know the route you are going to take to exit the building. If there is smoke in the building, stay near the floor. You will inhale less smoke by staying near the floor because smoke naturally rises. Before opening any doors, feel the face of the door and the doorknob for heat by using the back of your hand.
