During this event, we will be sharing the **California Opioid Use Disorder Toolkit: Supporting Public Health Response in Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health***. Training objectives:

- ▶ Attendees will be able to identify at least 3 risk factors for OUD.
- ▶ Attendees will be able to assess women for opioid use disorder using a validated screening tool, and list 3 actions to take if a woman has a positive screen.
- ▶ Attendees will be able to identify at least 2 treatment referral resources for women who screen positive.
