- **Print Team Roster -** Bring a printed hard copy of your team roster. You will not be able to check-in at the Regional without it.
- Load-In Process Up to 5 members from each team will be permitted to load-in on Wednesday from 6 PM to 9 PM or Thursday starting at 7:45 AM. To load-in, please bring your vehicle to North Congress Parkway on the north side of Credit Union 1 Arena. The load-in zone is indicated on the map found here and attached to this email. Please line up along Congress Parkway, spilling over to Racine Avenue if Congress Parkway is full. Once you're close to the garage on the east side of the Arena, you can check-in with a volunteer and start to unload your vehicle. After unloading, please proceed to Lot 11 to park your vehicle or to drop off your trailer. Please remember when bringing items, everything must go down the elevator except for items that are smaller than 24"x24"x24" and carried by an adult. - Safety Precautions Please ensure that your team brings enough safety glasses for your team members and potential guests. Please also remind all attendees to wear closed-toe shoes.
- **Respect the Venue** Please do not move any of the tables and chairs located throughout the venue for any reason. Additionally, please do not apply body paint or hair dye anywhere in the venue, including the restrooms.
- Student Ambassadors We are looking for student team members who are interested in providing guided tours to VIP guests. Students will walk them through the pits while explaining FIRST and FRC, as well as showing them match play while explaining this year's game. We're looking for students who are excited and willing to share their experiences with our guests. If you have interested students, please send them to Pit Admin or Volunteer Check-In to sign up.
- Safety Glasses Stations (2 stations) When checking-in, each team will be assigned two separate shifts to staff the safety glass tables. During each shift, your team will need to have at least two people at your designated safety glasses table for a two-hour shift.

- Outside Food As a reminder, outside food is not allowed to be brought into Credit Union 1 Arena, including the Arena's lobby, except for those who have dietary restrictions and have made arrangements before the Regional.
