2. Composition/Information on Ingredients

Coconut Fatty Acid / Lauric Acid (Fatty Acids) Sorbitol (Polyols)

4. Emergency and First Aid Procedure

Eyes and Skin: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.

Flush skin with water and consult a physician.

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air area and treat symptomatically.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Dilute with 1-2 glasses of water. Get medical aid.

5. Firefighting Measures

Flammability classification: Non-flammable.

Extinguishing media that must not be used for safety reasons: CO₂. Dry powder.

Special Fire fighting procedure/Suitable extinguishing media: Use of self-contained breathing apparatus and full protective equipment recommended. Water mist. Foam.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Spillage Procedures: Wear personal protective equipment. Ventilate area if spilled in confined space or other poorly ventilated areas. Prevent entry into sewers and waterways. Pick up free liquid for recycle and/or disposal. Residual liquid can be absorbed on inert material.

7. Handling and Storage

Advice on safe handling: Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid breathing dust/fume/gas/mist/vapours/spray. Keep dust to a minimum. Handle as an industrial chemical. Keep bag / container tightly closed.

Advice on common storage: Keep in a dry, cool and well ventilated place.

8. Exposure/ Protection meth

Respiratory Protection: Use respirator with an organic vapor and dust/mist cartridge if the recommended exposure limit is exceeded. Use self-contained breathing apparatus for entry into confined space, for other poorly ventilated areas and for large spill clean-up sites.

Ventilation: Local exhaust ventilation recommended to control dust exposure, protective gloves are recommended.

Skin Contact: protective gloves recommended

Eye Protection: Safety glasses or goggles recommended.
