

Using the Dowsing Rod

Dowsing provides a tangible connection to the Source as a validation of deeper intuition. You may be sure of your psychic or gut level insight, but *you may be wrong*. It is so easy for you (and every other person) to be influenced by your gentle heart and your tender intuitive nature. Using the wire gives you a check against your own desired result, your human foibles and, until you are more experienced, your lack of focus.

Ask these questions before dowsing: Ask these questions of all objects and beings, animate and inanimate, incarnate and discarnate. To do this, direct your inquiry to the highest Source for good of who or whatever you are intending to dowse and listen or feel for a response.

- 1. Do I have **permission** to work? [Permission?]
- 2. Is this for me to work on? [For me?]
- 3. Is this for me to work on now? [Now?]

These are my version of the old time dowser's questions: Can I? May I? Should I? Please do not ask silly or materially self-serving questions unless motivated to serve the highest good of all concerned. If you are screwing around or playing, you never will get accurate information.

Dowsing is a gift and your rod or pendulum is a sacred tool. Do not let anyone play with it or use it for fun. It may seem innocent enough, but you are building a conduit to the Source and, as a student, must guard against insulting this new style of relationship with the universal Source or down-playing its importance. It took Desda six years before she dowsed for anybody but herself and her immediate family.

Consecrate your rod to the work for which you intend to use it. If you want to do healing work with it, use it only for this purpose unless you re-consecrate it to dowse for other purposes. Re-consecrate it to fit your intention. Hold the rod in both hands. Place the L point at your brow and say:
