

THOMAS M. DROWN (1842-1904)



Thomas Drown was a chemist who taught at Harvard, Lafayette, and M.I.T. before going to Lehigh. He was Secretary of A.I.M.E. for eleven years beginning in 1873 and was elected President for 1897.
