

James Adee Timpson (1820-1907) was President of the Lehigh & Susquehanna Coal Company – the Lehigh & Susquehanna Railroad was a subsidiary of the Lehigh Coal and Navigation and built the Ashley Planes. Both L&S were leased to Central of NJ in April of 1871. Timpson retired and lived the rest of his life - 38 years living in the Wyoming Valley Hotel (September-May) or the Glen Springs Hotel (in summers).
