

Our "John White" graduated from college and began studying law in New York City but abandoned it to become a coal dealer, often with offices in the Trinity Building at 111 Broadway. An early venture was to operate the McNeal Coal & Iron Company, Yatesville Colliery, near Mahanoy City, two breakers with a combined capacity of 1200 tons per day, employing 450 men and boys. He also bought/leased the West Lehigh Coal & Iron and combined them, under I. A. Stearns, superintendent. The P&R C&I bought them in 1874.


