Professor Emerita Fiona Doyle obtained her bachelor's degree from the University of Cambridge and her master's and doctorate in extractive metallurgy and hydrometallurgy from Imperial College, University of London. She joined the faculty at U.C. Berkeley in 1983 and was appointed to the Donald H. McLaughlin Chair in Mineral Engineering in 1998. She served as Chair of the Department of Materials Science and Engineering from 2002 to 2005 and Executive Associate Dean of the College of Engineering at Berkeley from 2005 to 2009, from 2011 to 2014, and in 2022. From 2009 to 2011, Doyle was Vice Chair and Chair of the Berkeley Division of the Academic Senate. She was the Singapore Berkeley Research Initiative on Sustainable Energy program leader from 2013 to 2015. Doyle served as Vice Provost for Graduate Studies and Dean of the Graduate Division from 2015 to 2019. Doyle currently serves as a Special Advisor to the Dean of Engineering at Berkeley on Academic Matters.
