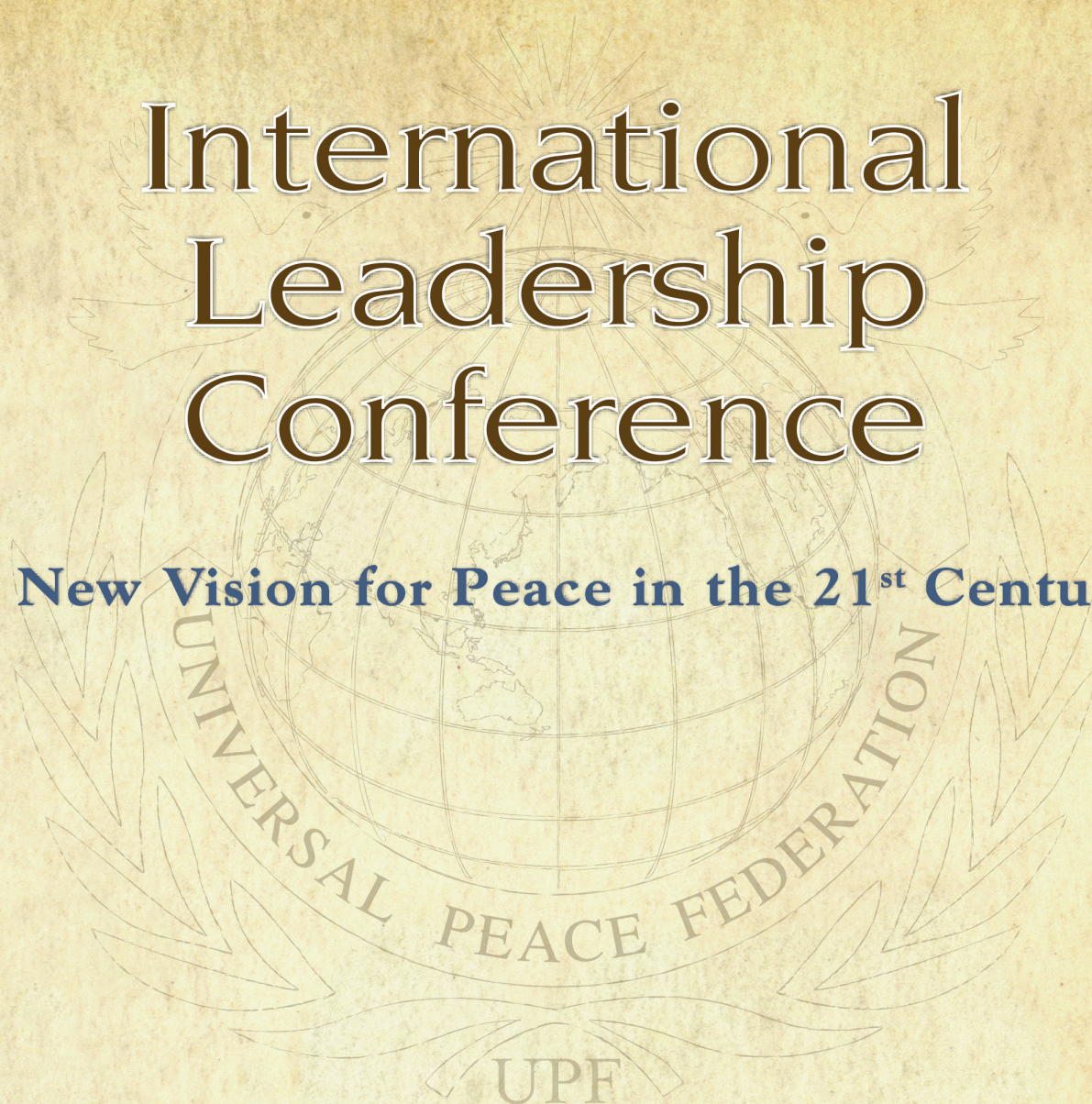






THE GLOBAL PEACE TOUR 2009



The Global Peace Tour promotes a platform of interfaith, family, and service for the sake of renewing our communities and nations. With the vision of "One Family Under God," we are spreading a new paradigm of leadership rooted in universal spiritual and moral principles, values, and aspirations. The tour is a continuation of our work for United Nations renewal by promoting the establishment of an interreligious council at the United Nations, an understanding of human rights as "endowed by our Creator," and multisectoral partnerships for the advancement of the Millennium Development Goals. People of all faiths are invited to come together in a spirit of mutual appreciation to resolve conflicts, promote God-centered marriages and families, and spread a global culture of service.

Starting in Japan, the tour visited over 50 nations and featured not only speeches by notable speakers but also meaningful service and interfaith activities. The last stop on the tour was at the United Nations Headquarters in New York, to commemorate the UN International Day of Families. More than 400 UN diplomats, Ambassadors, NGO representatives, and faith leaders celebrated the UN International Day of Families in the event sponsored by the Permanent Mission of Guinea, with additional cosponsorship from the Permanent Missions of Ethiopia, Iraq, Nigeria, Qatar, Sudan, and the Permanent Observer of the African Union.
