The Women's Federation for World Peace was established on April 10, 1992, by the Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon. It is a non-profit organization made up of members from all parts of society, based on the vision of "Humanity Is One Global Family in a Peaceful World under God." Since 1994, WFWP volunteers have been going to 160 countries, providing humanitarian support based on local needs, and developing education and service activities to empower the world's women. Based on these activities, WFWP was approved by the United Nations Economic and Social Council as an NGO in general consultative status. WFWP supports the UN MDGs through giving and service, international exchanges and reconciliation, and collaborative activities. In Korea, it promotes the unification of the North and South through education and aid to the women and children of North Korea.

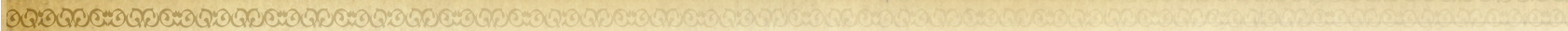
