Bicycles Agreement and Registration Form (Fall 2021- Spring 2022)

GALLAUDET UNIVERSITY CAMPUS BICYCLES POLICY AND PROCEDURES

- Anyone parking a bicycle or moped on Gallaudet University campus must register their vehicle with Gallaudet University, Department of Public Safety and obtain a GU bicycle permit.
- Inoperable bicycles are not permitted to be stored at Gallaudet University and are subject to removal by DPS.
- Gallaudet University is not responsible for damage or theft of any bicycle parked on Gallaudet campus.
- All bicycles parked on the GU campus are required to be secured to a bike rack with a bike lock. Any bicycle/moped found parking in a walkway or on a sidewalk will be removed by DPS.
- If bicycle/moped is lost or stolen, report to DPS immediately to file a report.
- Mopeds and bicycles must be parked at designated bike racks; bicycles fastened to trees, railings, parking meters, light posts, etc, will be removed and brought to DPS. Any bicycle or moped found unattended and unsecured in a walkway or on a sidewalk will be removed and brought to DPS.
- It is recommended that your bicycle be taken home with you at the end of the spring semester. Any registered bicycles left on GU campus over the summer must be reported to DPS prior to the end of the spring semester. Any bicycle not reported to DPS is subject to removal by DPS.
- GU bicycle permits should be placed on the front of the bike frame, on the head tube. The permit must be displayed at ALL TIMES.
- After 90 days, confiscated bicycles or mopeds that have not been claimed by its owner maybe placed into a charity action and sold to benefit Gallaudet student scholarships.
- Bicycle and moped parking is a first-come, first-serve bases.
- If a registered bicycle is sold, the original owner must contact DPS with the date of sale and the name of the new owner.
